Baptism with Fire

1. Hebrews 12:9-13 – Baptism with Fire

- a. The day the Son of Man judges the bloody city: fiery fury and wrath Eze 22:2-22
- b. For those that endure/remain: purity, holiness, righteousness, peace-Isa 4, Mal 3:3-4
- c. Afterward...the fruit of righteousness = peace Jam 3:18, Isa 32:14-18; 32:1-4
- d. "wherefore, lift up the hands..." Isaiah 35:3
- e. "make straight paths" Isaiah 40:1-3 → Speaks of John the Baptist Mt 3:1-13

2. Hebrews 12:14-17 - Don't Fail

- a. "Follow peace" This is where the beatitudes go Mtt 5:9
- b. "and holiness" Mtt 5:8, Matt 5:48 "no man shall see the Lord" Mt 7:12, 23-28
- c. They need to see your good works, and hear your confession Matt 5:16-20, 10:32
- d. "Look diligently..." The same thing the law taught Deu 4:9, 11:13, 11:22,
- e. "fail of the grace of God" This is not the grace Paul speaks of 1 Pet 1:13-16, Ja 4:16
- f. Their grace is the new covenant, but if they don't bear fruit they will not enter in
- g. "root of bitterness" A reference to Deu 29:18-21
- h. Their entrance to the kingdom depended on it -Acts 8:20-23, 2 Pet 1:10-11;
- i. Esau had a birthright, sold it for meat, and could not repent 12:16-17 (see Heb 4:1)

3. Hebrews 12:18-24 - Two Mountains

- a. Mount Sinai the old covenant Exo 19:16-19; 20:18-22; Deu 5:24-27
- b. Mount Sion the new covenant which is far greater and more worthy of fear
- c. One cannot be touched the other cannot be reached
- d. They stepped away from Sinai they can't escape from Sion

4. Hebrews 12:25-29 – The Great Shaking

- a. "much more shall not we escape" compare to Heb 2:3-4; Luke 21:34-36
- b. The shaking is of God's judgment on the world Hag 2:6, 2:21-22; Isa 13:13; Joe 3:16
- c. The shaking happens in Matt 24:29 after the tribulation Rev 6:13, Mk 13:25
