# The Terms of God's Grace

## 1. 4:4-5 - The Lust of the World is to Envy

- a. The lusts are described in James 3:14-16 and 1 John 2:15-17
- b. Envy leads to death Satan Isa 14:12-14, Adam, Joseph, Moses, Jesus Mat 27:18
- c. David and Solomon warned against this Prov 3:31, Psalm 37:1-2, 73:3-13, 17
- d. "The scripture saith..." Does not need to be a mistake. Eze 33:31, Exo 20:17

### 2. 4:6 - Grace to the Humble

- a. A non-exact quote from Prov 3:34 or Psa 138:6, By humility is life Prov 22:4
- b. God gives grace to whom he will Exo 33:19 and Romans 9:15-16
- c. "grace" mentioned 38x in OT, 4x in MMLJ, 90+ times by Paul, 23x Hebrew epistles
- d. 4:7-9 God gives grace to all men at all times, if they come on his terms.
- e. Grace is not an obligation, it is undeserved; obedience does not earn it.
- f. Lowliness, selling your possessions, exhibiting good works, is not your terms- Ro 5:8

### 3. 4:7-10 - The Terms of God's Grace

- a. Resist the devil, he will flee, ... but you may be killed 1 Pet 5:8-9, Rev 12:9-11, 17
- b. Who will ascend into the kingdom? The clean and pure Psalm 24:1-4; Isa 1:15-16
- c. Be afflicted and mourn, it is a time of weeping Psa 119:71, 126:5, Jer 31:8-11
- d. The afflicted will be rewarded, woe to the rich Luke 6:20-25
- e. God gave grace to his friends (but now even to his enemies) 1 Pet 5:6, Heb 4:16;
