Gifts According to Grace

1. 12:2

- a. What does our reasonable service to the Lord look like? We need instruction.
- b. The form of this world: pursue pleasure, possessions, power 1 John 2:16
- c. The renewed mind is when you put on Christ Eph 4:23, Col 3:10, Titus 3:5

2. 12:3

- a. "grace given unto me" the dispensation of grace 1Cor 15:10, Rom 15:15, Eph 3:2
- b. "every man" Be grateful for clear answers to dispensational questions.
- c. "not to think of himself more..." Religious pride as in Rom 11:18, 1 Cor 4:6, Gal 6:3
 - i. Why? They had powers, they had gifts remember we are in mid-Acts.
- d. "soberly" the lost art of a sound mind, a level head, in control 1 Cor 9:19, 26-27
 - i. The ability to discipline yourself to do what you know is right.
- e. "God hath dealt to every man" not just you, can I say you are not special?
- f. "measure of faith" The allotment, portion, the means 2 Cor 10:7-18
- g. Not God gifting you the ability to believe, nor is it measured in a cup.
- h. When faith has power it is because of God not us 1 Cor 12:9, 13:2, Mk 11:23
- i. What is the measure of faith? Gal 3:2; Abraham's was Rom 4:19, ours is Rom 4:24

3. 12:4-6

- a. 12:4 is referring to the human body having different parts with different roles
- b. "one body in Christ" A doctrine unique to Paul's office and ministry (not a tree)
- c. The body is still one, even with different offices Eph 4:4-6
- d. "having gifts" This is when gifts were still given, it is not you 1 Cor 12:4-14
- e. "gifts differing according to the grace" a different function, not for show of power.
- f. The gifts here were not a talent or ability for showing God's power (Tebow, Idol)
- g. The gifts are different than the snake handling and poison drinking of Mark 16
- h. These gifts are for the edification of a new creature Eph 4:7-12
- i. Gifts were given till we have the mature doctrine to grow up Eph 4:13-15
- j. "proportion of faith" That is the right doctrine, according to the grace given Paul

4. 12:6-8

- a. Prophecy was to be for the edification of the church 1 Cor 14:3-4
- b. Ministers, teaching, exhortation (preaching) = perform your role Eph 4:12
- c. "let us wait" Like a waiter, it means attend to that, not for your own profit
- d. "Giveth with simplicity" not with duplicity, or boasting 2 Cor 9:7
- e. "ruleth with diligence" not being lazy, or vainglorious Phil 2:3
- f. "mercy with cheerfulness" Mercy given should be a gift, not a bitter pill.
- g. The point: the gifts according to grace established God's will, not theirs.
