 - a. God is not a man...- Numbers 23:19
 - b. 1 Timothy 3:16
 - c. Greek Tragedy → Romans 1:21-23,25
- 3. ... says Man can have the answers "your eyes shall be opened"
 - a. We justify our disobedience 1 Cor 1:18-20,22-24
 - b. The wisdom of God is foolishness 1 Cor 2:14
 - c. 'Cursed be the man that trusteth in man' Jeremiah 17:5,7,9-10
 - d. God's thoughts are higher than our thoughts Isaiah 55:7-9
- 4. ... says that Man can be god "ye shall be as gods"
 - a. Romans 7:18 flesh dwelleth no good thing
 - b. The positive nature of man man is naturally good?
 - c. Exodus 19:4-8; ← wrong answer Right answer→ Hosea 14:1-3
- 5. ... makes Man the judge "knowing good and evil"
 - a. Are you the judge? Romans 2:1-3
 - b. Knowing good and evil you invent the code, the morality
 - c. Man becomes the ultimate authority
 - i. Gal 6:7 God is not mocked
 - d. Independence from God when they ate
 - i. There were two trees in the garden Gen 2:9, 2:17
 - e. 2 Timothy 4:1 God will judge the quick and the dead
 - i. We judge things, but not ourselves -- 1 Cor 2:15, 4:4
- 6. Satan's Lie: "You're on your own, work hard and you will succeed"
- 7. **God's Truth:** "You're not alone, live for the glory of God, trust in Him"
 - a. Grace: God's free gift apart from any merits of man Titus 3:5 Col 1:12-14
 - b. Being free is trusting in God at all times Romans 5:15,21 1 Tim 4:8-10
 - c. Free from sin and death, servants of righteousness Romans 6:18
