Catamaran Sunset Tour

Family, Marine & Nature

Experience the best sunset in the area on board of a catamaran. Set sail at 2:00 pm* to enjoy a relaxing afternoon on board of a comfortable vessel, taking in the views of Costa Rica's Gold Coast.

With a tropical cocktail in hand, sit on the prow gazing at the sea in search of marine life. Enjoy a short stop for snorkelling and kayaking in the cool Pacific waters, before going back on board to snack on chicken burritos, various dips, fresh fruits and cookies.

Then it's time to relax and watch the sun melt into the horizon.

Included: transportation from/to your hotel in Flamingo, Conchal and Portrero area, beverages, snacks, fruit and bilingual guide.

Beach Hopping & Snorkeling

Marine & Family

This tour will let you experience 8 very distinct beaches, all in close proximity of each other.

The tides will determine the order you visit each destination. Enjoy the sunsets of Flamingo Beach; the warm beaches of Playa Grande in Tamarindo, one of the best places to learn to surf, and the gorgeous Conchal Beach.

Cruise the Pacific before stopping to enjoy a refreshing dip in the water. Put on a snorkeling mask to get glimpse of marine life below the surface. Spot turtles, dolphins, manta rays and the rare whale!

The crew will prepare a beach BBQ for lunch. You'll continue to lounge, play or explore before heading back.

Included: snorkel gear, boat transport, snacks and lunch.

Snorkeling Tour

Marine, Relaxation & Family

One of the best snorkel sites in Costa Rica is 45 minutes offshore from Flamingo Beach.

Snorkelers often find themselves surrounded by large schools of colorful fish, and abundance of manta rays, stingrays and sometimes turtles.

All participants should be physically able to climb a small ladder into the boat and be comfortable in the water and able to swim. Life vests are available.

Included: mask, fins, and snorkel.

**From other locations, transportation is additional, amount depends on the exact location.*

Buena Vista Full-Day Combo

Canopy/Zipline, Horseback Riding & Spa

Buena Vista is located near Rincon de la Vieja National Park. A short hike takes you up to the canopy zip line.

There are 9 zip-cables ranging from 150 – 400ft, giving you the opportunity to view the dry forest from a different perspective.

Horseback ride to the natural spa and enjoy rejuvenating thermal hot springs and steam mud baths on the slopes of the active Rincon de la Vieja Volcano. Cool off on the 1200 ft. long water slide.

Included: lunch, transportation from/to your hotel, park entrance, horseback riding, zip line, waterslide, mud bath, hot springs, bilingual guide, equipment, soft drinks & drinking water.

Guachipelin Adventure Full-Day Combo

Rock-Climbing, Rappelling, Zip Lining & Riding

This tour combines climbing, rappelling, zip lines, horseback riding and canyons. Scale out of a deep ravine via a climbing wall, superman as you zip through the air, and horseback through pastures and dry forest.

Take a break from your activities to enjoy a traditional Costa Rican lunch. Finish your day at the hot springs (depends how many people are inside), which are heated by the Rincón de la Vieja Volcano.

Be sure to paint on the warm mud: the properties are extremely therapeutic. There are showers and changing rooms on-site to use before you head back to your hotel.

Included: lunch, transportation from/to your hotel, bilingual guide, drinks, towel and park entrance fees.

Borinquen Combo Tour

Adventure, Family & Nature

Borinquen is located in Rincon de la Vieja National Park. This resort is near the base of Rincon de la Vieja Volcano and sits on an untouched part of the transitional forest. Start the day with a horseback riding trip over the mountain, enjoy a 40-min ride that takes you through the forest to get to the canopy. Borinquen has the latest in engineering technology for canopy tours and is the highest in Guanacaste, great for thrill-seekers. Before leaving and after lunch, you need to indulge yourself in a mud-bath followed by a dip into thermal waters.

Included: Lunch, roundtrip transportation, horseback riding, bilingual guide, canopy, mud bath & hot springs.

Sensoria Waterfall Hike & Hot Springs

This full-day tour entices all your senses. Hike the well-maintained trails at the base of an active volcano for a 3 - 4 hour adventure.

Discover three natural pools, three waterfalls with thermal waters, a canyon and two waterfalls. At the end of your hike, take a refreshing dip in one of the azure pools, or in the hot springs warmed by the volcano.

Finish with a traditional lunch back at the Center.

This tour is ideal for adventurers and nature lovers looking for an off-the-beaten track location. Good physical condition is required.

Included: lunch, transportation from/to your hotel, bilingual guides, park entrance fees, towels, refreshments.

Tamarindo Surf Lessons

Sports

Tamarindo is the most popular and well known “surf mecca” in Costa Rica. With warm waters all year round, great waves and a professional instructor with unlimited patience to teach you, a surf lesson in Tamarindo is a must.

Surfing in Tamarindo is perfect for beginners getting on the board for the first time and also offers advanced surfers great surfing opportunities like the Tamarindo Estuary River break and reef breaks.

Start the lesson with a demonstration on the beach; the instructor will show you the correct body and board position, how to get in the water, how to paddle, etc. After that, head into the ocean with the instructor who will help you catch a wave!

Private version available.

Included: bilingual guide, rash guard, and surf board.

Canopy Zip line Tour

Once you arrive on the site, you'll be fitted with the gear and participate in a safety briefing.

The tour is offered in the morning and afternoon.

No maximum weight allowance, but harnesses must fit safely around waist in order to participate.

Included: transportation from/ to your hotel, bilingual guide, equipment and drinking water.

Whitewater River Rafting:

Class II & III

Sports

Arrive at the side of the Colorado river and be fitted with a helmet, life-jacket and paddle.

Spend 2 hours rafting down the river with your professional bilingual guide. The river is a great rafting experience for beginners and intermediates.

The narrow river is surrounded by lush vegetation and amazing wildlife such as monkeys, iguanas and tropical birds. At the end of your adventure, enjoy a traditional Costa Rican lunch.

Rafters need to be in moderately good physical condition. No rafting experience required.

Included: lunch, transportation from/to your hotel, bilingual guide, equipment, entrance fees and drinks.

ATV Tour – Guanacaste Area

Adventure, Nature & Sports

Pick between two routes: a beach and a mountain tour. On the beach tour you'll drive to four beaches and have lots of opportunities to take photos with stunning scenery behind you.

The mountain tour passes through authentic Costa Rica villages, sugar cane plantations and primary rainforest with a short break at the waterfall for taking some photos or dipping in the swim hole.

Children under 5 not allowed. 16 is minimum age to drive. Maximum weight is 400 lbs.

Included: fully equipped ATV, safety helmet, and bilingual guide. Depending on the location of your hotel, there may be additional transportation fees and time.

Tenorio River White Water Rafting

Class III-IV

Adventure, Nature & Sports

A wet and wild expedition! Paddlers will be delighted with this wet and wild experience combined with lush riverside scenery. This tour includes a rafting adventure on the Tenorio (Class III-IV rapids) located near the town of Cañas, or Toro River (also III and IV class rapids). The trip on the river lasts about 4 hours and includes lunch on the river bank with sandwiches, fresh fruits, natural beverages and some snacks. At the end of the Tenorio tour, we will have a 15 minute walk to the vans before you return back to the hotel.

Included: Lunch, transportation from/to your hotel, bilingual guide, rafting gear, snack, bottled water, and juice.

Eco Adventure Park Day Pass Nature, Adventure & Culture

With one of Guanacaste's largest animal sanctuaries and an almost mile-long zip line with ocean view, Diamante Eco Adventure provides a great combination of thrilling adventures and educational moments. There is something for everyone: jaguars, monkeys, crocodiles and sloths live in the sanctuary, while those who want more excitement can experience a dual canopy with free fall. If you prefer to rest and play at the beach, there is also the chance to do watersports like SUP and kayaking. If you prefer, it's possible to get a short tour of the sanctuary, the canopy, or the cultural experience. Make the most of your day with a tour for the whole family!

Transportation is charged separately and price depends on hotel location

Horseback Riding Tour Nature & Adventure

Experience the typical forest of Guanacaste lands while horesback riding! Enjoy a relaxing ride through a variety of forest and mountain trails and beaches. The horseback riding takes approximately 2 hours, starting with an extensive briefing on how to ride.

While riding, stop to take in the views of the tropical dry forest. Your guide will show you different plants along the way, and with just a little bit of luck you will be able to spot some typical Costa Rica wildlife, too!

Included: transportation from/to your hotel from Papagayo and Tamarindo areas, bilingual guide, horses, beverages, entrance fee, and insurance



DURATION: 3h **AGE:** 8+ **INTENSITY:** Rate per person: **\$70**

ESSENTIALS: Long pants, closed off shoes, repellent, sunscreen, hat, equipment, insurance and water.



Barra Honda Cave Spelunking & Hike Adventure & Nature

Arrive at the Barra Honda National Park for a one-hour hike to the entrance to the cave. As you walk through the jungle, keep an eye out for coatis, agoutis, anteaters, and monkeys.

Once at the entrance of the cave, rappel to the cavern floor to begin your spelunking. Spend an hour exploring the cave, the stalactites, stalagmites and rock creations of all shapes and sizes.

Then, return above ground for lunch.

This tour requires good physical condition and is not recommended for anyone with claustrophobia or fear of the dark.

Included: lunch, transportation from/to your hotel, bilingual guide, safety helmet, flash light, snack, bottled water and juice.

DURATION: 6h **AGE:** 10+ **INTENSITY:** Rate per person: **\$178**

ESSENTIALS: Hiking shoes or sneakers, comfortable clothing (pants or long shorts), sun hat, sun block and insect repellent.

Secluded Beach & Snorkeling Tour Family, Adventure & Sports

Cruise around Culebra Bay in a motorboat to enjoy the views of the Pacific coastline and then settle on a secluded beach to enjoy the day. On the way, it's possible to throw a few fishing lines in to try and catch an additional piece for the grill (optional)! Once the beach is selected based on the best available conditions, prepare to experience the Papagayo Peninsula via some snorkeling and stand-up paddling while the menu grills on the BBQ. Since the beach options are not easily accessible by land, the areas are usually not crowded. This half-day tour is all about enjoying a little bit of everything.

Included: round-trip transportation, naturalist guide, snorkeling and stand-up paddling equipment, fishing poles, drinks, light snacks, and full BBQ lunch.

Hanging Bridges & Rainforest Tour Nature & Family


Heliconias Private Reserve is located between two volcanoes—Miravalles and Tenorio, and offers spectacular views of the rainforest, wildlife observation and birding.

If you are staying in the Guanacaste province and still want to experience Costa Rica's rainforest, this is a great option. We'll pick you up from the hotel for a 3-hour drive to the reserve.

Walk along trails and hanging bridges suspended throughout the rainforest canopy. Your naturalist guide will help you identify plants, birds and other wildlife.

This tour is especially popular among birders.

Included: lunch, transportation from/to your hotel, entrance fee and bilingual guide.

Corobici River Floating Tour Nature & Family

Corobici River is perfect if you have been dreaming about the joys of white water rafting. The waters are not rough, but you have to work out to manage them. The river is class I - II.

The tour is a two-hour boat trip down the river, which is bordered by tropical dry forest. Admire trees like ceiba, mahogany and guanacaste. You may see rare exotic birds, Jesus Christ lizards and monkeys. Before boarding the rubber raft, a certified guide will instruct your on your safety procedures.

Included: lunch, transportation from/to your hotel & bilingual guide and safety equipment.

Estuary Safari Boat tour

Nature & Family

This leisurely boat ride through an estuary is an excellent opportunity for wildlife viewing. Explore the tropical dry forest cruising through the mangroves. The 1500-acre Tamarindo Estuary is teeming with wildlife, including 180 species of birds, and the american crocodile.

A guide will tell you about the unique ecosystem and its flora and fauna as you guise the calm waters. Keep your eyes out for iguanas, howler monkeys, and many tropical bird species. Stretch your legs as you take a short nature hike through Las Baulas National Marine Park.

Included: bilingual naturalist guide, bottled water & fruit, transportation (from Tamarindo and Langosta).

Birdwatching Tour

Nature and Family

With over 875 species of birds, Costa Rica remains one of the top birding destinations in the world. This tour will give you the opportunity to enjoy many of the species found only in the tropical dry forest of Guanacaste.

Look for the white-throated magpie jay, the elegant trogon, laughing falcon or the squirrel cuckoo. Your experienced guide will help you spot your most wanted species. This tour requires departing at 4:45 am.

Included: transportation from/to your hotel, beverages, local expert guide and park entrance.

Tamarindo Mangrove & Estuary Boat Tour

Nature & Family

The mangrove boat tour is a great way to explore the natural beauty and wildlife in this area. The large estuary divides Tamarindo beach and Playa Grande and is surrounded by dense, tropical dry forest. It's a protected wildlife refuge that spans over 500 hectares. Board a small boat and glide through the canals spotting an abundance of wildlife, flora and fauna along your way.

Your local, bilingual guide will be a wealth of information and will help you spot howler monkeys, herons, kingfishers, crocodiles and many colourful birds. You can also view the native Tamarindo and Guanacaste trees.

Included: transportation from/to your hotel, drinks, fruits, boat tour and local expert guide.

DURATION: 3h | **AGE:** ALL | **INTENSITY:** [Lightning Bolt Icon] | Rate per person: \$64

ESSENTIALS: Comfortable, cool clothes, sandals, hat, binoculars, camera, sunscreen, and insect repellent.

Santa Rosa National Park Hike & Souvenir Shopping Tour

Nature, Culture & Family

On this tour you will hike through the first protected park established in all of Costa Rica, enjoying both a history lesson and abundant wildlife. You'll spend your morning hiking through tropical dry forest, where you can encounter deer, coatí and other small mammals, monkeys, and 250 species of birds. This hike is considered easy and lasts 2-3 hours. Then visit one of Costa Rica's most important monuments, La Casona, located within the park. This former hacienda is a landmark of many battles over the past two centuries! Finally, head out to Liberia for some souvenir shopping. Lunch is on your own.

Included: transportation from/to your hotel, professional certified bilingual guide, entrance fees, and bottled water.

Green Sea Turtle Nesting

Nature

This is a great trip for anyone who wants to observe sea turtles in their natural habitat. Starting this evening tour, you will first be registered at the park station before you witness this incredible feat of nature.

The local guides—turtle spotters, will let the the guide know they have a turtle preparing for nesting, and (s)he will inform you of the proper ways to observe and respect the mothers. Typically, you will see between 4 to 6 turtles on this trip. Please note that lights affect nesting females and hatchlings so cameras are forbidden! This tour is seasonal and available only between November and January.

Included: transportation, guide, water bottle, entrance fees and sandwiches.

ESSENTIALS: Passport copy, hiking boots or sandals; wear warm clothes or bring jacket. No cameras are allowed!

Palo Verde National Park & Tempisque River

Nature

Palo Verde is one of the most important and interesting national parks in Costa Rica. It has at least 12 different habitats within the park including mangroves, swamps, swamp forests, saltwater and freshwater lagoons and marshes. Our transportation will take you from your hotel to the Tempisque River. Once there, enjoy a 2.5-hour boat ride and watch the array of wild birds and other animals such as howler monkeys, green iguanas, coatís, anteaters and crocodiles. The park provides shelter for a great variety of birds such as the american woodstock, the boat-billed heron, the tiger heron and the tropical kingbird. This is a great tour for those who love nature and bird watching!

Included: lunch, transportation from/to your hotel, drinks, fruits, boat tour and local expert guide.

Rincon De La Vieja National Park Tour Nature

Rincon de la Vieja National Park is home to one of the six active volcanoes in Costa Rica, last erupted in September 2011. It is also home to many terrains such as volcanic rocks and dried lava flows, bubbling hot mud pools, eerie steam holes, waterfalls and beautiful jungle trails to explore!

If you are looking for an authentic wildlife experience, this is definitely a tour for you! After the hike, visit a typical Guanacaste town of Liberia. The local guide will explain bits & pieces of its history. End the tour with some souvenir shopping.

Included: lunch, transportation from/to your hotel, beverages, local expert guide and park entrance fee.



DURATION: 7h | **AGE:** 7+ | **INTENSITY:** [Lightning Bolt Icon] | Rate per person: **\$115**

ESSENTIALS: Train shoes with grip, long pants or shorts, T-shirt and a hat. Bring binoculars, camera, and insect repellent.

Two-Tank Scuba Dives Adventure, Marine & Nature

Just 45 minutes offshore from Flamingo Beach lies one of the most exciting dive sites in Costa Rica. It is an area where divers often find themselves surrounded by large schools of colorful fish, an abundance of manta rays, stingrays and several species of sharks.

There are several dive spots with depths ranging from 40 ft. to 100+ ft. Your dive masters will choose each site based on the conditions. Visibility depends upon the levels of plankton in the water, as well as the weather.

Included: BCD, regulator, mask, fins, and snorkel if needed, weights and weight belt and wet suit. Light snacks and drinks on the boat.

ESSENTIALS: Bathing suit, change of clothes, sun screen, sun hat, PADI Certification card, and a towel.



Miravalles Volcano Combo Tour Nature

Travel to the Guanacaste mountain range and admire the Miravalles volcano with all it has to offer. The trip takes you to the mountains and the very foot of the volcano to see the geysers. Then ride on horseback for 40 minutes across trails to see waterfalls and local wildlife. Afterwards, enjoy a mud bath and the natural hot springs from the volcano.

Included: transportation in an A/C bus, lunch, water bottle, naturalist guide, entrance fee to the park and the hot springs.

DURATION: 8h | **AGE:** 7+ | **INTENSITY:** [Lightning Bolt Icon] | Rate per person: **\$162**

ESSENTIALS: Bathing suit, hiking or running shoes, binoculars, camera, sunblock, change of clothes, rain poncho, bug repellent, sandals that you can get wet, hat.

Open Water PADI Certification Course Adventure, Marine & Nature

Get certified as a diver so you can explore the ocean wide and large. Your expert Dive Masters will guide you through all the steps of this 4-day course. At the end you'll emerge a PADI certified Open Water diver. The course includes theory lessons, pool practice sessions, and 4 ocean dives. The diving sites are located 45 minutes offshore from Flamingo Beach, where you can spot schools of fish, stingrays, sharks, and more.

You'll need to study and complete each level before continuing on to the next. Your certification at the completion of this course is PADI Open Water Diver.

Included: all necessary equipment, PADI certified instructor, booklet, diving log, snacks and drinks on the boat.

Discover Scuba Diving Adventure, Marine & Nature

If you are not a certified diver but would like to experience the world under the waves, this tour is for you! This is not an actual scuba certification course. You will be paired with a PADI certified instructor to learn how to use scuba equipment in shallow water and get a quick and easy introduction to what it takes to dive.

Your guide will give an explanation of the basic components and techniques used in diving. The dive sites are underwater formations of volcanic rock and coral. The visibility is between 25 and 50 ft and the maximum depth is 40 ft.

Included: boat, briefing, diving equipment, oxygen and emergency equipment, cooler with cookies, juice, water and fruit.



TOUR DURATION

TIPS FOR TIPPING

Tipping is a personal choice, but you should know that most people who work in tourism here depend on tips as part of their income. While it's not expected; it's definitely very much appreciated.

The amount you tip is based on the length of your tour as well as the service of your guides. For a short , half-day or less tour \$3-\$5/person is sufficient. For a longer or full-day tour \$7-\$10/person would be appropriate. Tipping for fishing trips is usually 15%-20% of the cost of the fishing trip.
