

Scholarship Guidelines

The OCLGA scholarship amount is not defined and is based on OCLGA's availability of funds.

Any member may recommend a candidate.

The scholarship committee will bring the final selection(s) to the membership for a vote.

The candidate must meet all the following qualifications:

1. Be a female who is a resident of Prince Georges County
2. Attends college or is a senior in high school and is accepted at a college
3. Plays on a golf team or plans to enter a field related to golf
4. Has a 3.0 GPA or better
5. Writes a short essay about her goals or speaks to the OCLGA membership or the scholarship committee
6. The same recipient may be selected each year that she is in college and must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA at the end of each year.

The scholarship will go directly to the recipient in the form of a gift card that may be used as desired by the recipient.

The recipient may be invited to be our guest at a game with OCLGA members.
