Ukrainian violinist Aleksey Semenenko, named as *Musical America's* "New Artist of the Month" for March 2015 and praised for his "verve, *delicatesse*, and beautiful phrasing", opens the DSO Season with **Tchaikovsky's** exhilarating Violin Concerto in D Major. The Russian master's enchanting Symphony No. 2 in C minor, known as the *Little Russian*, incorporates a variety of charming Ukrainian folk songs. *Sponsored by Savant Capital Management*
