- The symphony underwent many revisions. In older
- drafts, the composer included descriptive movement
- 49 titles, such as "Summer Marches In" and "What the
- 50 Flowers of the Field Tell Me." These were
- eventually omitted in favor of simple tempo
- 52 markings. The work was also pared down from seven
- to six movements.
- Movements 4 and 5 of Mahler's Third Symphony are
- concerned with Mankind and Angels. Mahler makes use
- of the human voice in these sections with parts for
- 57 mezzo-soprano soloist and a treble chorus. Petra
- Lang, our soloist, spoke further about the role of
- the voice in this piece:
