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- In a memoir published in 1959, Marie Stejskalová 26 [SHTAYs-clove-UH], a maid in the Janáček household 27 for over four decades, took credit for giving the 28 composer the inspiration for The Cunning Little 29 The Vixen was a character in what we'd now 30 call a comic strip in a Brno newspaper in the 1920s. 31 Gavin Plumley, one of the world's leading Janacek 32 scholars and curator of the website: 33 leosjanacek.co.uk spoke further about the origins 34 of this work: 35

  38 work (along with a nostalgic tone) have, at times,

  against a tree for a nap. His slumber is disturbed
  when a curious Vixen cub chases a frog right into
  his lap. Against her will, the Forester decides to
  take the vixen home as a "pet."
- AB: Time passes through a lush orchestral interlude and 55 we see that the Vixen--now grown to a young adult--56 has been tied up in the Forrester's yard. 57 she keeps company with a collection of farm 58 animals-including a conservative old dog and 59 several chickens. Unhappy with domesticated life, 60 the Vixen chews through her rope. He then tricks 61 and kills the chickens...and escapes. 62
- In Act II, the Vixen is back in the forest, where AB: 63 she has evicted a Badger from his lair. Over 64 drinks in a nearby inn, the Pastor, the Forrester 65 and the Schoolmaster discuss their mutual 66 infatuation with the gypsy girl Terynka. The 67 drunken Schoolmaster leaves the inn and mistakes a 68 sunflower behind which the vixen is hiding for 69 Tervnka and confesses his devotion to her. Keith 70 Jameson discusses the Schoolmaster's role in 71 greater depth here: 72

- 74 AB: The Forrester, also on his way home, sees the Vixen
- and fires a couple of shots at her, which sends her
- running. Later, the Vixen--now entering womanhood--
- meets a charming boy-fox. They retire to the

- full of gossipy woodland creatures necessitate
- 80 their marriage, which...rounds out the act. Isabel
- Bayrakdarian-our Vixen-discussed the "completeness"
- of her role:
