3 AB: ...we hear **Messiah** by Handel. I'm Alec Baldwin.

12 AB: ...and now we hear Part I of Messiah by Handel.
13 **Alan Gilbert conducts...The New York**
14 **Philharmonic**.

15 (MUSIC)

16 AB: **That was Part I of Messiah by George Friedrich**
17 **Handel. The New York Philharmonic and the**
18 **Westminster Symphonic Choir were conducted by**
19 **Alan Gilbert. We'll have Parts II and III**
20 **following a pause for station ID. I'm Alec**
21 **Baldwin and you're listening to the New York**
22 **Philharmonic This Week**.

25 conclusion of Messiah by Handel.

26 (MUSIC)

27 AB: We just heard a complete performance of
28 Handel's Messiah. The New York Philharmonic
29 and the Westminster Symphonic Choir were
30 conducted by Alan Gilbert. As soloists, we
31 heard: Soprano Celena Schafter, Mezzo-Soprano
32 Nancy Maultsby, Tenor Kurt Streit, and bass-
33 baritone Jonathan Lemalu.
