2017-2018 Financial Agreement (PERCUSSION)

The purpose of this agreement is to provide you with an overview of the costs involved in participating as a member of the Claudia Taylor Johnson High School **VARSITY BAND**, a program offering of Claudia Taylor "Lady Bird" Johnson High School and the North East Independent School District. In order for the band to function, there are fees required for membership. Below, we explain for clarity, the fee system in place for 2017-2018.

Your signature on this agreement is a commitment to participation in the **VARSITY BAND**. Please be certain that you understand all of the requirements before you sign your name. A parent/legal guardian **MUST** co-sign this agreement, regardless of whether or not the band member is over the age of 18.

Financial obligations for the members of the 2017-2018 Claudia Taylor Johnson High School Band (PERCUSSION) are as follows:

I. VARSITY BAND Enhancement/NEISD Uniform Fee - \$1,150.00

Please read through the financial letter for details on what is covered under the Band Enhancement Fee.

A. Schedule of Payments

1. OPTION 1 – Standard Schedule

After August 1st, there will be a 2% late fee added to the remaining balance due.

2. OPTION 2 – Custom Schedule

Custom payment schedules are available, but should be agreed upon in writing with the Head Band Director prior to June 1, 2017.

B. Tuition Refunds

1. Voluntary Termination of Membership

If for any reason you decide that the Johnson High School **VARSITY BAND** is not for you and you withdraw by your own choice, we have in place a refund schedule that is prorated depending upon the date of termination. Please read this policy carefully. We will withhold a certain percentage of fees paid as determined by the date that you have chosen to terminate membership. Realize that the later you depart, the more severe the penalty due to non-refundable travel expenses, consultant salaries, and production costs.

NOTE – all decisions to terminate membership should be communicated through e-mail, fax, or mail with the Head Band Director. The date of departure will be considered the time that written communication is received by our office.

The schedule below assumes that you have in fact paid all fees on a timely basis. Students who are behind in payments will still be responsible for paying the fees associated with the schedule below. I.E. – should you terminate your membership with band; you are still responsible for the portion of the payment listed below next to the date to cover costs associated with participation.

Withdrawal Date	Enhancement Fee Payment Forfeited
Prior to June 1st	\$200
June 1st – August 1st	\$400
August 2 nd – September 1st	\$650
September 2 nd – October 1 st	\$900
After October 1 st	\$1,250

The money above is the amount that will be retained by the Johnson Band to cover the cost of non-refundable travel, consultant salaries, and drill/music arrangements. The later a student drops, the more money is retained to cover expenses.

Should student decide to move from VARSITY BAND to PEP BAND only, non-refundable money will be transferred to cover the costs of participation in that ensemble and no additional fees would be due.

2. Involuntary Termination of Membership

"Involuntary Termination" of membership includes removal from the band program for disciplinary issues, OR medical release. Should life circumstances (i.e. loss of employment) cause a student to not be able to participate/travel, we will meet to discuss the situation case-by-case with each family and our administrator to determine a refund plan.

If your membership is terminated due to grade ineligibility or flagrant misbehavior (destruction of property, insubordination, fighting, hazing) you shall receive <u>NO</u> refund.

3. Termination Due to Injuries

If a student is injured and is unable to participate, we will meet to discuss the situation case-by-case with each family and our administrator to determine a refund plan. If a student is injured, but can still travel – we will explore this option. We will need a doctor's note to verify the medical situation.

II. NEISD Uniform Fee (Brass, Woodwind, & Percussion)

Included in the \$1,150.00, the NEISD Uniform Fee for Brass, Woodwind, and Percussion covers use of a district uniform(s) (marching for male/female, tuxedo for male), 4 dry cleanings of the uniforms, and custom fitting of the uniform through the year.

III. Percussion Fee - Sticks/Mallets/Heads/Supplies/Consultants - \$100.00

The Sticks/Mallet Fee covers the purchase of sticks and mallets for percussion students for the full year. It also covers the cost of using the school percussion instruments, and any repair issues that may come up through using them.
