Eastern Connecticut Symphony Chorus Announces Auditions

The Eastern Connecticut Symphony Chorus (ECSC) is currently seeking singers for their 2017-2018 season, performing concerts titled *Testament of Freedom, A Celebration of American Heroes* on November 11th and singing selections from George Frideric Handel's *Messiah: A Christmas Celebration* on December 2th. Auditions will be held on Wednesday, September 13, 2017.

The ECSC offers singers a unique opportunity to join a musical enterprise of symphonic proportion in Southeastern Connecticut. Individuals selected for a position in the chorus will have the fortune of performing *Candide*, an operetta with music composed by Leonard Bernstein at the Garde Arts Center on April 28, 2018.

Auditions are by appointment only and will begin at 7:00 pm. Participants are expected to prepare two songs of symphonic, hymns or church music; those auditioning will also be asked to vocalize and sight read. Participants should bring the piano accompaniment scores of their chosen songs to the audition; an accompanist will be provided.
