#### At a Glance

Curated by Music Director and Conductor, Toshiyuki Shimada, the ECSO presents six classical concerts annually from October to April, many of which feature guest soloists. The orchestra is made up of 68 contracted musicians from in and around the southeastern Connecticut region. All six subscription concerts are performed at the historic Garde Arts Center on State Street in New London. Free lectures, sponsored by the Friends of the Symphony, precede the classical concerts. ECSO is also contracted for additional concerts, such as performances with the Eastern Connecticut Ballet in presentations of "The Nutcracker", chamber performances at senior and community centers, and cathedral concerts in Norwich, CT. ECSO's educational efforts reach thousands of area schoolchildren through Music in the Schools programs and Young People's Concerts at the Garde Arts Center.
