THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TUTTLE PUBLIC WORKS AUTHORITY MET IN SPECIAL SESSION ON **OCTOBER 14, 2016 AT 5:00 P.M.** IN THE TUTTLE CITY HALL BUILDING LOCATED AT 221 W. MAIN STREET

CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL Chairman Chester called the meeting to order at 5:08 p.m.

Young announced Council Member Littleton could not attend due to a previous scheduled appointment.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

1. RE-CONSIDERATION of amendment to the sanitation services contract with Allied Waste (now Republic Services) to provide curbside recycling.

Mayor Chester asked for comments from the public.

Elberta Jones of 5902 Cessna Lane asked if the recycling is mandatory for all residents. She said the City should have provided more information about the program. Steve Atkins 5818 Cessna Lane asked why it was not voted on by the residents. He asked how much money the trash company is making on this program. Crystal Griffis of Republic Services responded to the questions. Recycling will keep the cost of trash service from increasing in the long term due to not having to build new landfills. Republic currently does not make money on recycling.

Motion was made by Smith, seconded by McLeroy to re-consider and approve adoption of amendment to sanitation services contract for curbside recycling. Motion carried as follows:

Aye: Buck, McLeroy and Smith

Nay: Chester

Chester announced he voted no due to his request to consider a discount on recycling for senior citizens and handicap citizens.

McLeroy asked that the Council consider the discount rates at the next city council meeting.

Smith noted that the City has agreed to pay .12 of the \$3.12 price for each citizen.
