City Council Seat Elections

Are you interested in serving your community? If you have lived in the City of Tuttle for at least two years, and have lived in the one of the two West wards for at least 6 months, then you are eligible to run for the City Council. Council members for Wards 3 and 4 will serve for 4 years, taking office in May 2013. Those who will be running for these two offices will need to file their candidacy forms with the Grady County Elections Board between 8:00 am on Monday, December 3, 2012 and 5:00 pm on Wednesday, December 5, 2012. New Toy Drop-Off & Pick- Up

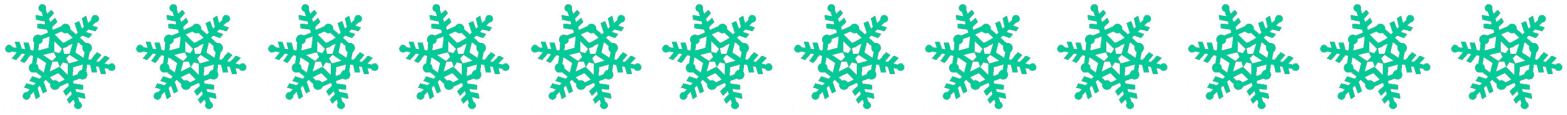
The Annual Tuttle Fire Department Toy Drive is underway and currently accepting donations.
