MISSED TRASH SERVICE:

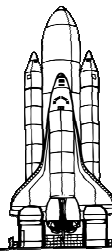

City Ordinance: Animal not to be at Large: Chp3, Sec. 3-2

It shall unlawful and an offense for the owner of any animal, domestic or wild, (including dogs), to permit the same to be, run at large or trespass upon the premises of another person, or be unlawfully at large at any time within the corporate limits of the City of Tuttle, Oklahoma.
