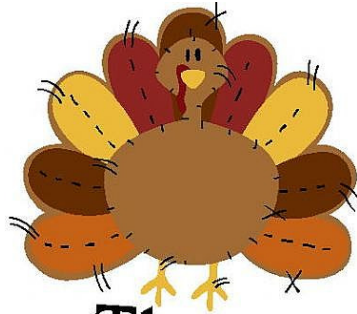

### Residential Parking Do's and Don'ts

The City of Tuttle Code Enforcement has been receiving numerous complaints regarding various parking issues in Tuttle neighborhoods. Over time, the City Council has adopted various regulations to help keep residential areas looking attractive and to help maintain property values. The following are some reminders regarding parking in residential areas.

Parking on the Front Yard is Not Allowed. In 2011 the City Council adopted an ordinance prohibiting the parking of any vehicle in a residential front yard for longer than four hours. Vehicles must be parked in a designated parking area, such as in a garage, driveway, or in a back yard. Vehicles can also be parked on the street where not prohibited, and can partially park on the grass next to the street where necessary to allow traffic to use the street. Vehicles cannot use sidewalks as a parking space. If unique circumstances exist that potentially justify parking in the front yard, you can apply for an exception by filling out a form at [www.cityoftuttle.com](http://www.cityoftuttle.com) or at City Hall.

Typical commercial vehicles, such as company vans and light trucks, are allowed. The Tuttle Zoning Code does not permit the overnight parking of commercial vehicles exceeding one and one-half (1 1/2) tons rated capacity in residential areas.

Travel trailers and recreational vehicles may only be stored behind the front yard building line. They can be parked in the driveway for a short period only while the travel trailer or recreational vehicle is being prepped or cleaned. Travel trailers and recreational vehicles cannot be occupied at any time in residential areas.

All new driveways and parking areas require a permit from the Community Development Department. This includes the installation of paved or gravel parking adjacent to city streets.
