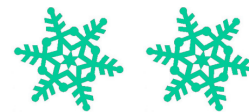
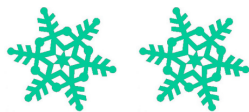

Cimarron Rd Phase 2 is Complete!

With the exception of some very small cleanup issues, the reconstruction of S Cimarron Rd from Main St to Tuttle High School is complete. This was the second phase of rebuilding Cimarron Rd. improvements included replacing the worn asphalt with concrete, wider lanes, underground storm drains for improved drainage, curbs and gutters, new school zone lights, school pedestrian crossing and signal, and replacing sewer lines installed in the 1920's that were under the road. This was completed using funding from the Capital Improvement Fee, the 1% Streets, Alleys, and Sidewalks 1% Sales tax (\$343,000), Utility System Fees (\$138,000), Capital Improvement Fees (\$182,500), and Surface Transportation Program funds administered by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (\$1,337,500), for a total Phase 2 cost of \$2,001,000. The drainage improvements will allow for other drainage improvements in the area in the future.

Phase 1, completed in 2010, added left turn lanes on for traffic on Cimarron Rd, replaced the traffic signals, added left turn signals and pedestrian crossing signals, improved the drainage, replaced the worn asphalt paving with concrete, added curbs and gutters, and added a center turn lane to improve traffic flow to the school athletic facilities. This was completed using funding from the 1% Streets, Alleys, and Sidewalks Sales Tax (\$218,100), funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (\$225,000), and the Surface Transportation Program funds administered by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (\$22,500), for a total Phase 1 cost of \$465,600.

Planning for these improvements began in 2006. The City Council is now working to develop a plan to make improvements to other roads in Tuttle. S Sara Rd from SH-37 to the south will be reconstructed by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation and Grady County beginning in 2015. Efforts are already underway to seek federal and state funding to resurface N Cemetery Rd, N and S Morgan Rd, and S Frisco Rd. An overlay plan is also in the works for various streets that do not qualify for federal or state assistance located in various subdivisions.

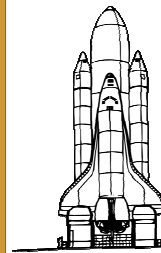
