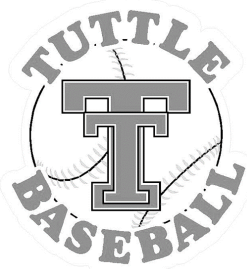

City of Tuttle Residential trash pickup is every Tuesday within the city limits. Please have your trash cans out Monday evening to ensure your trash can is emptied. Pick up begins at 6:00 am on trash day. Customers outside of city limits may have a different trash day.

The City of Tuttle requires all businesses and homes to have trash service. This is necessary in order to ensure that trash is not allowed to accumulate anywhere in the City. Trash accumulation is not only unsightly, but can result in disease outbreaks. Protecting the overall health of our residents is our highest priority. Cleaning up accumulated trash also takes precious tax money away from other needed services. Tuttle contracts with Allied Waste to provide trash pick-up within the City limits. By contracting with one trash pick-up provider we are able to use volume pricing to keep your trash bills low. Trash trucks are very large and heavy. As a result, trash trucks contribute to damage to our streets. By limiting the number of trash trucks on our roads, we are able to slow further deterioration of our already-poor quality roads.

TPWA UTILITY INFORMATION

Utility bills are due by the 15th of the month. Bills are late and a penalty of 5% is added on the 16th day of the month. A \$25 late fee will be added to all accounts that are not paid in full by 5:00 pm on the 21st day of the month. Please be aware your utility bill due February 16, 2015 is for water service from the third week of December through the third week of January and gas service is for the entire month of December.

Primary Elections:

Tuesday, February 10th, 2015 is the Primary Election date for City Council Member Position in Ward 1 as well as the School Bond issue. Only voters living in Ward 1 can vote in the city council election. To find your ward go to www.cityoftuttle.com
