## City Council to Consider Recycling

Republic Services, the City's trash service provider, has presented the City Council with an option to provide curbside recycling. City Hall receives several calls throughout the week from individuals asking about our recycling options. Currently, the City of Tuttle does not provide any options for recycling.

We recognize our society's growing desire to prevent waste and to reuse what we use. Unfortunately, recycling does have a financial cost. Polycarts have a price, and must be occasionally replaced due to wear and tear. Additional trucks are needed for the additional pick-up, along with the need for additional drivers and fuel for the trucks. There is a cost to operating the recycling sorting facility, and so on.

The proposal we received is to provide bi-weekly recycling pickup to all residential customers. All materials to be recycled will be placed in a new special-marked polycart that is the same size as our normal polycarts. The cost will be \$3 per household per month. This pricing is only available if recycling is provided to everyone.



The City Council will begin deliberations and will potentially make a decision regarding Republic Service's recycling proposal at their July 11, 2016 meeting. Since this will be a new, yet non-critical, service, the City Council is seeking input from the public to gauge interest. **The City Council has not made a decision regarding this particular recycling proposal.** A quick survey is available on our website at [www.cityoftuttle.com](http://www.cityoftuttle.com). **AUTOMATED METER READER  
INSTALLATION**

Public Works has started installation of the new automatic read water meters. This work will be completed by both Public Works employees and outside contractors.

The crews will be working from 7am to 7pm Monday through Friday. We anticipate all designated water meter conversions to be completed by November, 2016.

The installer will give a courtesy knock on your door to inform occupants of a brief interruption of water service estimated to range from 15 to 30 minutes. You do not need to be home for the conversion to be completed.

Changing the water meter may introduce a small amount of air and can break loose deposits inside the water pipe thus causing the water to have air in it and sometimes a discoloration. Allowing your water to run for a few minutes after the conversion will dissipate the air and discoloration.
