UPDATED WATER METERS

The city of Tuttle is updating their water meters. In speaking to Aaron Slattery, Public Works Director, he talked about some of the existing water meters which could be 20 to 30 years old.

Water is a very precious resource. Until now, meter readers would walk around town, open the manhole cover, and look through the cobwebs and dust to read the numbers on the meter. Then they would bring those sheets into the city hall where they were entered into a computer. This reading and entering was a time consuming process.

Now, one person can drive by these new meters and a laptop computer will collect the information in a matter of seconds. Those numbers will automatically go into the billing computer. This saves time and makes the

numbers accurate.

It was impressive to note that if a person questions his water usage, a report may be printed out to show the accurate usage hour by hour and day by day.

Aaron mentioned that after the first reading, you may see an increase in your water usage, as the old meters were not accurate. But within a few months, you will be confident in your water usage.

For example, people may not realize how much water is used by a watering system. Another example is the water usage from those long showers. This is another example how technology is saving our community money by making our process more efficient and it will also help us in recording how our water is being utilized.
