## CITY COUNCIL - AN OPPORTUNITY TO SERVE

It is impressive to see citizens who take their time to serve our community. There is an opportunity to serve on the city council for those citizens from wards 3 or 4.

The city council listens to the people in their ward. Then they share those thoughts with the other city council members. The council members are able to provide leadership and guidance for our community. This leadership will impact our lives and the lives of our children for many years.

If you have the desire to run for the city council, here are a few of the requirements. You must be at least 25 years of age. You have lived in the City of Tuttle for at least two years, and have lived in one of the two wards

for at least 6 months, then you are eligible.

Council members for Wards 3 and 4 will serve for 4 years, taking office in May 2017. Those who will be running for these two offices will need to file their candidacy forms with the Grady County Elections Board between 8:00 am on Monday, December 5, 2016 and 5:00 pm on Wednesday, December 7, 2017. ## FYI: RECYCLING

By now, everyone has heard about recycling and how much energy it takes to make a new aluminum can compared to the advantages of recycling an old aluminum can.

However, let's take an economic look at recycling. From recent studies, 3/4 of our waste can be recycled. The savings would be in energy, trees, resources, and CO2.

When we look at the tremendous amount of waste that goes into our landfills, we are personally impacted by the cost of building new landfills which are VERY EXPENSIVE! The cost of building a new landfill would increase our trash bill.

service bill in the near future.

That is the way economics works. There is no Free Lunch. For example, we want more services like clean water and it cost money to dig the wells, run the wells, clean the water and keep the pipes operating efficiently.

Trash service works the same way. We want "someone" to come by and haul off our trash. And, as the cost of disposing of waste goes up, our trash bill will go up!
