Old Business

Solicitor Stone reported the easement agreement with William Kuriger has been signed to give access to the waterline on Old Hill Rd. for the relocation project.

Solicitor Stone recommended the Authority give an official response to the West View agreement by the end of the year. Len Kinter made a motion to approve the latest version of the West View water agreement as negotiated by the Authority with all the appropriate and approved amendments. Claudia Brenneisen seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

New Business

Bill Davis reported the Township has a major leak in the system. The master meter is reading very high. Bill Davis and Bill Taylor have used all resources to locate the leak or leaks. An outside leak detecting

company has been called in and is actively working with Bill to find the leak. Four customer leaks were located and the customers were alerted. Those leaks were repaired by the residents.

Bill Davis reported the Glenfield master meter pit is in need of repair. To address this concern, the Authority asked Bankson Engineers to prepare an estimate to bring the meter and pit up to date.

The bids for the Old Hill Road waterline replacement were received and opened. Rudzik Excavating Inc. had the lowest bid at \$205,720. Bankson reported to find them dependable and recommended the Authority accept the bid. Len Kinter made a motion to award the bid contract to the lowest responsible bidder, Rudzik Excavating Inc., in the amount of \$205,720 contingent on receiving of the CITF grant. Claudia Brenneisen seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Len Kinter made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 4:45. Tom St. Clair seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
