Bylaw Change for Spousal **Membership**

Changes to the club's bylaws to accommodate spousal memberships will have the third and final reading at the February meeting before taking a vote immediately afterward for approval. The addition is as follows:

Article VII, Section 3

C. Spousal Members – A spousal member is one who is legally married to an active General, Senior or Honorary Life member.

1. New members: a spousal member will begin as an associate member for the first year and pay the full dues of an associate member. All privileges and requirements of an associate member would apply. The spouse may stay an associate member as long as desired. After one year, an associate member may become a general spousal member for one half (1/2) the current rate of general membership and full initiation fee. All privileges and rules for general membership apply and can be renewed as long as maintaining legal married status to an active member in one of the previously listed categories. In the event the spouse does not maintain an active membership for any reason or becomes deceased, the spousal member would need to transfer to a general or associate membership status upon the next membership year.

2. Current associate members: A current associate member can become a general spousal member for one half (1/2) the current general membership rate as long as all qualifications for general membership have been met.
