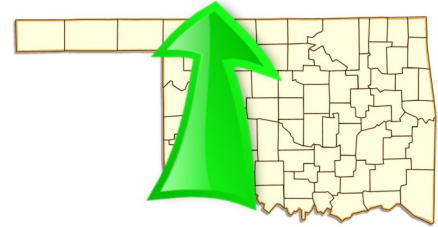




Sandhill Crane



It would be hard to imagine a fall or spring without the bugling of large flocks of sandhill cranes flying overhead. In spring they are migrating to their breeding grounds in the northern reaches of North America.
