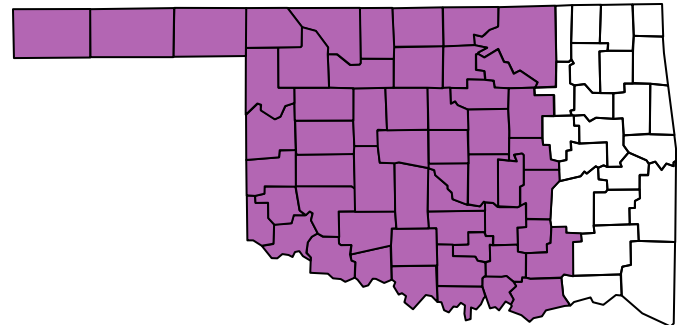




Spotted Towhee



This large member of the Sparrow family is primarily a winter visitor in the western 3/4 of Oklahoma. It can be found in shrubby habitat feeding on the ground in leaf litter. It does a two-footed, backwards-scratching hop to uncover seeds and small invertebrates they feed on.
