Rules

One entry per participant/group.

No entry fee

There is **no theme** for the gingerbread houses, just an opportunity to use your imagination to create the holiday house of your dreams!

Judges - Three impartial judges (tba)

Awards - Winners in each category will receive 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place **ribbons**

Size - The Gingerbread house must be placed on a base made of ¼" plywood, no larger than **24" x 24"**.

This ensures stability and portability of the house.

Title - All entries **must have a "title"**.

Materials - All entries are considered non-edible and may be constructed of any material (glue, milk cartons, boxes, etc.) As long as the finished piece resembles a gingerbread creation of candies, sweets, crackers, etc.

A separate category will be created for houses made of **authentic gingerbread**.

Note: If real icing is used, please use the royal icing recipe (dries hard).

We suggest royal icing for decorative purposes.

Powered meringue also makes an excellent icing. The recipe is on the box.

Can be found in the hobby aisle at walmart or hobby lobby.

Hint: glue works better to hold parts together.
