We are *collecting travel size toiletries* such as sample size shampoo, conditioner, lotions, toothpaste and brushes, floss, etc. These items will be taken to the *Ronald McDonald Support House* at Mercy in Ft. Smith and to Little Rock. We are also collecting Best Choice labels found at CV's *Foods* to be used in benefiting *Southern Christian Home and the Paragould Home*.

BUILDING SECURITY...Part of our added security measures is the changing of locks here at the building. All outside locks have been changed to a keypad entry system. We have also installed locks on the classroom doors in the foyer which can only be opened from the inside. (*When I say we, I mean Lowell, of course.*) In the event of an intrusion our usher will press the alarm which will automatically lock the classrooms and outside entrances. The door locks will be opened when you arrive for either Bible classes or worship. These same doors will automatically lock again at 10:45 on Sunday morning, 6:15 on Sunday evening, and 7:15 on Wednesday evening. This insures time for late arrivals to enter prior to securing the building once again. All of the safety experts state this central truth. *"The best way to stop an unwanted intrusion to the building during worship is to stop it at the door."* These precautions are intended to help with that. All of these doors can be opened from the inside at any time if we should need to exit for fire or other emergency. Any member needing to use the building for special activities will be given a passcode which will work for a limited amount of time. If you need the code for an activity please see Lowell.



At our next business meeting we will be continuing our discussion of forming policy and appointing our security team. We certainly solicit your input regarding any of these matters. More information will be coming.

"REMIND ME"...Joe Bridges will be presenting information this morning regarding a notification system to be used for cancellation of services or any change in our regular service schedule due to inclement weather. Getting the word out to everyone on a short notice is always a challenge, but this notification system should be a much quicker and more efficient one. It's the same system that our schools and city governments use when trying to get information out to a large number of people in a short period of time. He will be presenting information during adult Bible class time as well as taking a few moments after the morning announcements prior to worship.
