“IT IS FINISHED”

You all remember where Jesus was when He spoke those words, don't you? In *John 10:30* you find them recorded. Jesus was on the cross dying when He spoke those final words. If you could somehow dismiss the pain and suffering He was going through, I wonder what His emotion was. I think it may have been akin to joy. A joy that to some extent all of us have experienced. It's the joy of the finished task. It's the joy that comes from seeing something through all the way to the end. Some guy determines to write the great American novel. He struggles through three hundred pages only to give up on it, to set it aside, and never go back to it. There is no joy there...only sadness and frustration. Jesus finished His work on earth. He finished what He came into this world to do. He was “about His Father's business” at age twelve in the Temple, and He continued taking care of His Father's business until the cross completed it. He finished the work despite all the hosts of Hell who were determined to see Him fail. The temptations were very real. The discouragement, the frustration, the sorrow experienced when so many simply turned away from Him and His message were very real. But none of this cut short His work. His own words bear witness. *“I must work the works of Him that sent me.”* And work those works He did. Faithfully. All the way to the end. Despite the suffering that accompanied the work. The Hebrew writer reminded us of that when he said, *“who for the joy set before Him, endured the cross, despising the shame.”*

I say all this just to remind all of us here at Dayton that we too are “about our Father's business.” We live our lives and do our work knowing that *“the devil as a roaring lion walks about seeking whom he may devour.”* Our efforts to serve and honor God are not without opposition. The same kind of opposition our Lord faced. And each of us must face the reality of that just as He faced it. Nothing deterred Him. Absolutely nothing could cause Him to change the course God had set out before Him. He remained true to His purpose until His dying breath. Will we do the same? In a nation that seems to be drifting further from God, will we drift with them? What we are doing here is eternally important. **Let's be a people who are just as determined as He was to see thing through until the end...to be able to say with Him, “It is finished.”**
