WE KNOW

Does that sound arrogant to you? Some folks seem to think a humble person would always say "I don't know." *"And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know Him that is true, and we are in Him that is true, even in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life."* **I Jn 5:20** It certainly is true that there are many things we do not know. And it is true that none of us know everything. But the reality of that does nothing to the fact that we know some things...even some things about God. The agnostics among us are not unbelievers as the atheists are. They simply assert that, if there is a deity, it is impossible to know anything about him. They deny that there is any reliable revelation from God, and, therefore, no way we can know anything about Him if He exists at all. That thinking is in error. The word "agnostic" is a very old word that has been assigned a more modern meaning. It's found one time in the Bible in Acts 17:23 where Paul talks to the Athenians about the "unknown" (*agnostos*) god that they ignorantly worship.

It is true that we do not know everything about God. Many times in Bible class here at Dayton questions have been asked, and the best answer I could give was, "I don't know." But the fact that we don't know everything does not imply that we cannot know anything. There are sounds that you and I cannot hear. There are tones at the higher and lower ranges that are impossible to detect with the human ear. Those sounds certainly exist. We just cannot hear them. When God created the human ear He chose to place limitations on what we could hear. Why didn't He allow us to hear all sounds? I don't know, but I think He knew we would need a certain amount of quiet time in order to survive in a noisy world. The fact that we cannot hear some sounds certainly doesn't mean that we are deaf. It just means that we are limited. All of us as Christians know that God is God, and we are not. Though we are made in His image, He is so much more than any of us. To borrow a phrase from Paul, *"Now we know in part and see in part..."* We most assuredly can know, and must know, the things that God has revealed concerning both ourselves and Himself. The heights and the depths of God are yet to be revealed, but we must not turn a blind eye or a deaf ear to what He has shown and told us. *"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."* **I Jn 5:13** Let's each determine to live life in the confidence of this truth, *"I know whom I have believed."*
