THE GOOD SHEPHERD

"I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine." **John 10:14** Jesus described himself in a lot of ways while He walked among us. One of the most familiar ways is found in John 10. You've read John's gospel. You already know that all of the talk of Him being the good shepherd grew out of what took place in the previous chapter. Jesus was in Jerusalem, and in the Temple when He and the disciples walked by a blind man. You remember the disciples question. *"Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents that he was born blind?"* Jesus' response was both quick and clear. *"Neither one."* Jesus used spittle, dirt, a pool of water, and the man's willingness to do as Jesus instructed. The man was healed. It was the Sabbath day. Of all the days in the week to restore sight Jesus had to pick the Sabbath. Those educated in the Law beyond their intelligence seized upon the opportunity to publicly criticize our Lord for not keeping the Sabbath Day. They hauled the healed man into the court where the Sanhedrim met for questioning, and finally booted him out. It was in that setting that Jesus gave that tremendous message on the Good Shepherd. Those men who hauled the blind man into their presence regarded themselves as the shepherds of Israel, and here was a sheep that these shepherds did not know.

It's amazing, isn't it? This blind man had sat in those temple gates for years seeking alms. These shepherds had passed by him thousands of times as they entered the Temple, yet they did not know him. The good shepherd always knows his sheep. Whether you are talking about the shepherds in the pasture or the shepherds in the Temple. Israel had enjoyed many good shepherds. Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Abraham, Jacob, Moses, Jethro, Joseph, David, Amos, and the list goes on and on. The Bible names many shepherds...but only one supremely Good Shepherd. And that Shepherd knows His sheep. Do you sometimes feel ignored? Does it seem like no one really understands your situation and the challenges of it? Have you sat in church buildings with the feeling that no one really sees you when you are there? Regardless of whether others know or understand rest assured that the Good Shepherd certainly does. All of us are familiar with David's most famous Psalm in which he boldly declares, *"The LORD is my shepherd! I shall not want!"* Are you discouraged? The Good Shepherd knows the depth of your discouragement, the cause(s) of your discouragement, and just what is needed to alleviate it. If we will simply allow Him, He will *"lead us beside the still waters."* He will *"make us to lie down in green pastures."* He will *"restore our souls."* He will *"enable goodness and mercy to follow us all the days of our lives."* He does all of this and so much more because He is the Good Shepherd who knows His sheep. And...we know His voice. We all understand that there are many voices in this world, and all of them are clamoring for our attention. If we are sheep of His fold we have learned to distinguish His voice from all others. Jesus' words...*"And when He putteth forth His own sheep, He goeth before them, and the sheep follow Him for they know His voice."* **10:4** Jesus stands and calls out to us every day. Let's all be listening for His voice. When we hear it let's do the only acceptable thing to do...let's follow Him.
