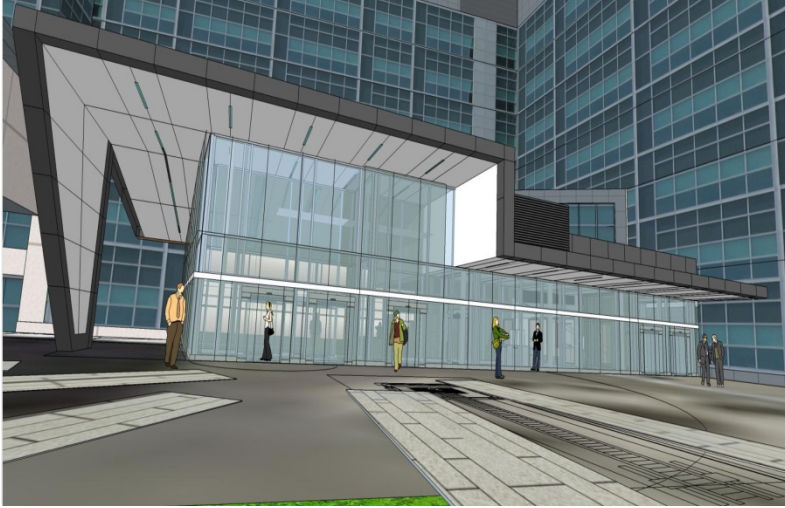


A. GRENVILLE & WILLIAM DAVIS COURTHOUSE ENTRANCE MODIFICATION Project Bulletin No. 7 September 11, 2018

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

- Construction of a new main entrance to better accommodate courthouse users and to enhance security.
- The new, larger main entrance has expanded queuing areas and will alleviate congestion by providing two security screening points.
- New security screening elements include: x-ray bag screening, magnetometer portals and optical portals for staff.
- Barrier-free entry and exit will be provided for the public and staff.
- Entrance expansion has added approximately 4,500 square feet to the existing building.
- The existing accessible parking spaces in front of the building have been relocated, allowing for the creation of an open pedestrian plaza with landscape elements.

CURRENT STATUS:

- Partial Occupancy Permit for Main Entrance has been granted by City of Brampton
- Substantial Performance walkthrough was conducted on August 21st, 2018
- Deficiencies are in the process of being addressed by the General Contractor, Brown Daniels Associates Inc. and this work will be ongoing for several weeks
- Training for all new security equipment has been provided to the Peel Regional Police
- Roof leaks are being addressed as quickly as possible by the Contractor, Consultant and Roofing Testing and Inspection specialist. Initial investigations have been carried out and schedule for completion of leak repairs will be communicated once available

UPCOMING PROJECT ACTIVITIES:

- Brown Daniels to complete any temporary measures needed for the front entry to be operational by September 13, 2018
- The hoarding around the main entrance lobby will be removed the night of Tuesday Sept. 18, 2018
- Temporary directional signage to assist in directing the public within the new entrance will be set up the evening of Tuesday, September 18, 2018
- The new main entrance along with partial paver walkway on the north side of the building will be open for use by the public on Wednesday September 19, 2018
- The temporary entrance will be removed, and landscaping and stone paver installation will continue. It is anticipated this work will be completed by the end of October 2018
