

BAIL APPLICATIONS

IN THE BRAMPTON SUPERIOR COURT OF JUSTICE

In order to effectively and efficiently schedule initial bail hearings on *Criminal Code*, s. 522 bail applications, and reviews under s. 520 and 521, the court requires sufficient time for the judge to review the material filed as well as realistic and informed time estimates for the hearing.

While Criminal Motions Courts scheduled every Tuesday at 11 a.m. and Friday at 10 a.m. will deal with most ss. 520 and 521 applications that are realistically estimated to take two hours or less, all s. 522 bail applications as well as ss. 520 and 521 applications estimated to take over two hours require a conference call “pre-trial” to obtain an accurate time estimate, establish filing schedules and fix a date when the application can be heard. Counsel are also required to request a “pre-trial” where the s. 520 or s. 521 review will involve transcripts of over 100 pages.

If you have an application that will require a conference call “pre-trial,” before filing any material:

1. Contact the assigned Crown for all s. 522 applications or determine if a Crown has been assigned for all other applications to facilitate scheduling.
