BRAMPTON COURTHOUSE ADDITION PROJECT – PARKING LOT WORK

TO ALL BRAMPTON COURTHOUSE STAFF:

What is happening?

Graham Construction will be performing work to run utilities from the new courthouse entrance to an electrical room on the north east side of the courthouse building. As such, the laneways for traffic entering and leaving the courthouse from the first County Court Boulevard entrance will be temporarily narrowed. Two-way traffic will be maintained for the duration of the roadwork and Graham Construction flaggers will be available to direct traffic. Temporary signage will also be in place to direct traffic. The temporary traffic plan has been reviewed and approved by the Peel Regional Police as well as the Brampton Fire Department.

When?

Signage will be in place and traffic will be directed starting on Monday, April 30, 2018 and lasting for approximately three weeks.

Why?

Running utilities into the existing electrical room is required as part of the new addition and new entrance projects.

How will this affect me?

Two-way traffic will be maintained at the first County Court Boulevard entrance, but the lanes will be temporarily narrowed. Graham Construction flaggers will be available to direct traffic.
