“Crossing the Red Sea” Exodus 14

The people of God had been delivered out of slavery and set free. However, they find themselves in what seems to be an impossible situation. They feel trapped and without hope, but with God nothing is impossible. God had determined that He would save his people through the Red Sea.

This deliverance is the epitome of the book of Exodus and the Old Testament. It is frequently referenced throughout the Old Testament as a point of reference for the power and salvation of God. In the New Testament, it is a pointer to the ultimate salvation of God found only in Christ at the cross (Lk. 9:31; Jn. 5:24). This important passage is essential for us today. As Romans 15:4 says, “For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.”

The plan (vs. 1-8) (Is. 46:10; Ps. 135:6; 115:3; Dan. 4:35; Ecc. 8:3;)

The people (vs. 9-14) (Heb.3-4; 1 Cor. 10; Phil. 3:10-11; Rom. 6:1-4)

- The fear of Israel (the dummy spitters)
- The faith of Moses (the mediator)

The promise (vs. 15-20) (Ps. 106:7-8; 76:10; Is. 43:25; Rom.8:35-39)

The power (vs. 21-31) (Rom. 1:16-17; Lk. 9:31; Jn. 5:24)

The Exodus story is a little picture of God’s greater story of salvation for all who put their trust in Jesus.
