“Wholeness” Exodus 29:43-31:18

We were created to enjoy the riches of God’s Glory (Gen3:1-13). Man’s rebellion against God is the cause of our brokenness (Gen3:14-24). Beholding the glory of God, we become Whole (2Cor3:18, 4:4, 6). What are the marks of people who are becoming Whole (Healthy/Holy)?

Exodus 29:43-46

Marks of People Who Are Beholding God and Becoming Whole:

Exodus 30:1-10

✓ **A Praying People** (Ps141:2; Luke 1:10; Rev5:8; Ps145:18)

Verses 11-16

✓ **A Grateful People** (1Pet:1-18-19; 2Cor8:9, 9:6-8)

Verses 17-21

✓ **A Cleansed People** (Ex38:8; James 1:23-25; John 15:3; Matt6:12; 1John1:8,9)

Verses 22-38

✓ **A Spirit-filled People** (1John2:20, 27; Eph5:18-21; Gal5:22-23)

Exodus 31:1-18

✓ **A Balanced (work/rest) People** (Ex18:13-18, 23; Mark 1:32-38; Mark 2:23-3:6)

Growing Notes

- 1) What does it mean that we were created to enjoy the riches of God’s glory (Gen3:1-13)? How has man’s rebellion caused our brokenness (Gen3:14-24)? How does beholding the glory of God make us whole (2Cor3:18. 4:4,6)?
- 2) Read Exodus 29:43-31:18. In Exodus 1-18 God rescues the Israelites from slavery in Egypt and in Exodus 19-40 en route to the Promise Land the Israelites come to Mt. Sinai, where God invites them into a covenant relationship using a tabernacle, priests and sacrifices (Ex24-29). What was the point of all of this (Ex29:43-46)?
- 3) Why do you think it’s true that the higher and the more accurate our view of God is, the stronger and the more secure and satisfied you’ll be in life? Why do you think people who are closest to God are most fired up about God? Where are you on this scale from one to ten: 1 (cold)-----5 (warm)-----10 (Hot)? Explain.
- 4) Review the five marks along with Bible references of people who are beholding God and are becoming whole. How do all these help us to increase our capacity to experience the presence of God and become whole? How is wholeness a team sport that happens best in community? What is God speaking to you through this study? How can you become better at beholding the glory of God? Pray.
