## Prayer

Father God, You made promises to Abraham and he believed You even though he didn't know what Your plans for him were. It can be hard for us, Lord, to be patient and BELIEVE that You also have a plan for us. Help us trust You and BELIEVE that You are always with us. Amen.

## **Blessing**

Blessings are from the Bible and are a way to infuse encouragement and love to another person. A blessing may be given at any time or place. Now invite your child to open their hands to show their openness to receiving your words:

May you feel God's love and BELIEVE His promises. He is always with you.

Ask your child what they learned today about God through the story of Abraham. **What was God's action?**
