Historic Hudson Valley to Cooperstown ~ May 10-17, 2019

We would love to have you join us on the New York Legends CARavan, an exciting tour of the central region of New York State. By driving through hills and valleys, discovering beautiful lakes and rivers, we will explore the legends and traditions that make this area so special. From horses to baseball greats, music icons, war heroes and political giants, we will tour through the areas that celebrate these fascinating people and animals. In addition, we will be visiting four outstanding car collections.

Our tour begins and ends in Saratoga Springs, home to the National Museum of Racing and Hall of Fame. On our first evening we will enjoy a wonderful reception at the Saratoga Automobile Museum, followed the next day with a boat tour on scenic Lake George and then a late afternoon tour at the Museum of Racing to learn about all the equine legends. On Sunday, we travel west to Gloversville to visit a fantastic private car collection, and then continue on to Cooperstown, where we spend three nights. While there, we see two more outstanding car collections, the Farmers' Museum, the Fenimore Art Museum and the Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum, enjoying the display of the many baseball legends. From Cooperstown, we head south through small villages driving on country roads to Bethel Woods, home to the famous Woodstock Festival of 1969, and then travel on to Poughkeepsie for an evening of dinner and dancing on the Hudson. The next day, we are treated to a wonderful drive along the Hudson River to West Point Military Academy for a tour, learning of its many legendary graduates, and lunch. That evening we are fortunate to have a terrific dining experience at the Culinary Institute of America. The last day of the CARavan, we drive north, stopping for a tour of "Springwood," the estate of Franklin D. Roosevelt in Hyde Park, before continuing north to complete our circular tour at Saratoga Springs and our final banquet.

The activity fee is \$1100, which includes 7 breakfasts, 4 lunches, 8 dinners, 6 museums, 3 special events and the car collections. Our hotels are: the Gideon Putnam in Saratoga Springs, the Otesaga in Cooperstown and the Poughkeepsie Grand in Poughkeepsie. The average hotel cost per night is \$178.

May should be a wonderful month in upstate New York, the hills will be coming alive with soft greens and spring flowers will be blooming everywhere. We are very excited about the CARavan and hope you will be joining us!
