Introduce the video by asking them: Has anyone ever really taught you how to pray? Tell them about how you learned to pray and how you wish you could have had access to a video like the one they are about to experience when you were their age.

EXERCISE: THE GEOGRAPHY OF PRAYER ...

Ask one of your class members to read aloud "The Geography of Prayer." Go through the regions of the world that we pray for during each decade of the Rosary. Ask the students to name countries in that region. Then ask them how they think life is different in those places. [WB106]

We cannot grow spiritually unless we get outside ourselves, and put other people and their legitimate needs ahead of our selfish and sometimes reckless wants. This exercise is designed to give perspective about how difficult life is for people in other parts of the world. The result of this perspective should be gratitude and a desire to help others.
