The Ipswich City Council Transparency and Integrity Hub presents a significant opportunity to rebuild the reputation of this council and contribute to restoring the trust of the Ipswich community.

Ipswich City Council (council) has taken a number of steps and implemented measures to meet its legislative obligations in the publishing of data to the Transparency and Integrity Hub.

This includes using best endeavours in the uploading of and checking of data and seeking necessary advice including the completion of an independent Privacy Impact Assessment.

The Privacy Impact Assessment is published on the Transparency and Integrity Hub.

Council is working with privacy experts and is consulting with the Information Commissioner and Privacy Commissioner with regard to publishing relevant personal information in a manner authorised by Queensland privacy law.

Council has published this information on the Transparency and Integrity Hub in line with its Open Data Policy to increase openness and transparency and in the public interest.

Council is bound by the following legislation (at minimum) and has published only that information which may be done so lawfully:

- a) *Information Privacy Act 2009 (Qld) (IP Act)*;
- b) *Right to Information Act 2009 (Qld)*;
- c) *Public Interest Disclosure Act 2010 (Qld)*;
- d) *Crime and Corruption Act 2001 (Qld)*;
- e) *Local Government Act 2009 (Qld) (LGA)*;
- f) *Local Government (Dissolution of Ipswich City Council) Act 2018 (Qld)*; and
- g) *Local Government Regulation 2012 (Qld)*.

In line with its obligations under the *Information Privacy Act 2009* and the Information Privacy Principles (IPP), council has acted to protect the privacy of individuals and not publish personal information unless it can be done in accordance with the IPP.

Original data has been published to the Transparency and Integrity Hub and information that could reasonably lead to the identification of individuals has been de-identified to ensure information privacy. Additionally, de-identification has been applied to information that could be considered to be commercial-in-confidence or that may waive legal professional privilege.
