This summary is based upon records of internal affairs investigations conducted by the Department's Office of Professional Responsibility.

All complaints reported to the United States Capitol Police's (USCP) Office of Professional Responsibility are documented as "cases." All cases are investigated in order to substantiate the complaints. **All substantiated policy violations involving USCP personnel result in the Department's taking disciplinary action, up to and including termination and/or corrective training, as deemed necessary.** Cases may be generated from within the Department (observed by USCP officials) or outside sources (visitors, staff, etc.). The number of "cases" refers to the number of complainants that contacted the Office of Professional Responsibility during the calendar year.

The total number of "sustained charges" refers to the number of allegations, following a thorough Office of Professional Responsibility investigation, internal review, and employee appeal process that were upheld.
