All cases are investigated in order to substantiate the complaints. **All substantiated policy violations involving USCP personnel result in the Department's taking disciplinary action, up to and including termination and/or corrective training, as deemed necessary.** Cases may be generated from within the Department (observed by USCP officials) or outside sources (visitors, staff, etc.). The number of "cases" refers to the number of complainants that contacted the Office of Professional Responsibility during the calendar year.

The total number of "sustained charges" refers to the number of allegations, following a thorough Office of Professional Responsibility investigation, internal review, and employee appeal process that were upheld.

SUMMARY OF INVESTIGATIONS

During Calendar Year 2020, the Office of Professional Responsibility (OPR) conducted 106 investigations. There were 137 allegations of misconduct associated with these investigations. As of February 8, 2021, 86 cases have been completed by the OPR, with 20 cases still under investigation.

All complaints and Department investigations are documented as "cases." All cases are investigated to substantiate the complaints, and individual cases may involve multiple allegations. **All sustained policy violations involving USCP personnel result in the Department's taking disciplinary action, up to and including termination, and/or corrective training, as deemed necessary.**

Cases with sustained allegations undergo an internal review and an employee appeal process.
