

## **Amendment to House Conference Resolution**

Offered by Rep. Ralph Norman (SC-05)

*Establishes Guidelines on when legislation can be voted on by the full House and prioritizes legislation that eliminates or reduces spending and existing federal programs.*

### **Rule ##---Guidelines on Legislation**

(a) The Republican Leader shall not schedule, or request to have scheduled, any bill or resolution for consideration---

- (1) Unless all committees of jurisdiction have acted on the measure or the majority of Republican Members serving on each relevant committee have signed a letter agreeing to waive their committee's jurisdiction.
- (2) Not accompanied by a cost estimate.
- (3) Not publicly noticed 10 days prior to consideration.
- (4) Establishing a new federal program without eliminating or reducing a federal program of equal or greater value.

(b) When scheduling legislation for consideration, the Republican Leader shall give preference to bills that eliminate or reduce spending and existing federal programs.
