SUMMARY OF INVESTIGATIONS

During Calendar Year 2020, the Office of Professional Responsibility (OPR) conducted 106 investigations. There were 137 allegations of misconduct associated with these investigations. As of February 8, 2021, 86 cases have been completed by the OPR, with 20 cases still under investigation.

This summary is based upon records of investigations completed by the Department's Office of Professional Responsibility.

All complaints and Department investigations are documented as "cases." All cases are investigated to substantiate the complaints, and individual cases may involve multiple allegations. **All sustained policy violations involving USCP personnel result in the Department's taking disciplinary action, up to and including termination, and/or corrective training, as deemed necessary.**

Cases with sustained allegations undergo an internal review and an employee appeal process.
