I request the following records from the Library of Congress pursuant to the provisions of Section 703 of Title 36 of the Code of Federal Regulations: digital copies of the Annual Report of the Congressional Research Service of the Library of Congress for fiscal years 1981-1995.

The Library of Congress routinely makes the Annual Report of the Congressional Research Service publicly available and currently has published the reports from FY2009-FY2018 on its website.¹ Additional CRS annual reports have been published via other sources, such as the Hathi Trust, and we have obtained and published online reports for 1971-1980 and 1995 forward.²

We are requesting these CRS annual reports as part of our analysis of how the Congressional Research Service historically has worked to meet the needs of Congress.
