Who could come up with a more religious-sounding notion than “Let’s just stop fighting, join forces and get along!” Many people get the religious *warm fuzzies* when they hear things like what follows:

“The world’s religions are all pretty much the same. They share many of the same principles. Principles like don’t steal and don’t kill people and treat others the way you’d like to be treated and such. And, besides, most of the wars are started because of religious differences. If we could somehow compromise and eliminate all the religious differences and just focus on the similarities we could create Peace on Earth!”

Large and rapidly growing numbers of the naive folk who buy into that have also come to believe that if you’re a good person, you’ll go to Heaven. So it doesn’t matter which deity you believe in, so long as you have good moral values.

The elitist philosophers who so easily manipulate that juvenile thinking bombard *the little people* with the claim that Christian Values have much more in common with the values of the other religions than not—and that even Atheists and Satanists believe in good values. (They don’t explain where and how those Atheist/Satanist *good values* are gotten.)

A significant part of that message is that Jesus would want us to get along peacefully, too, you know. Often, they even quote Christian scriptures; e.g.: “Follow peace with all men...” —Hebrews 12:14

The essence of the evil SPIN is “Compromise and Coexist.” But what does the Bible say about all that?



1 John 2:15_{ESV} says “Do not love the world or the things in the world, if anyone loves the world the love of the Father is not in him.” We could easily go on and on about that single point, but there’s quite a large collection of pertinent scriptures that you may want to review on your own. These should be good for a start—

Matthew 6:24, John 15:18-21, Romans 12:2, James 4:4 and Colossians 2:8. Then there’s this: “Truly, truly I say to you, he who does not enter the

sheepfold by the gate, but climbs in by any other way is a robber and a thief.”
—Jesus, at John 10:1_{ESV}



What of the claims that if we all compromise our beliefs and work to accept, tolerate and get along with everyone's beliefs that we can create peace on Earth?

Jesus' message at Matthew 24, Mark 13, Luke 21 and Revelation 20, etc., is that there will be no peace on Earth until after Judgment Day! That'd be after Satan's release for a short time, following Christ's thousand year reign with those who will have been *beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands...*
—Revelation 20:4_{KJV}

NOTE: To date, we have not been able to find any scripture that even implies that some extra special group of Christians will come back to Earth to reign with Christ after having partied on the streets of gold for seven years... Regarding war and tribulation, it is our conclusion that the scriptures show that “We ain't seen nothin' yet!”

But what of the claim that “As long as you're a good person, you'll go to Heaven.”?

Nothing could be further from the truth. Ephesians 2:8,9 says that we're saved by grace, through faith, not of works. 1 Corinthians 1:1-4 tells us that this faith is the ongoing demonstration of our belief in Christ's death for our

sins, His burial and resurrection after three days. Those who're so easily identified with *the religiously correct* crowd get offended by that. If your philosophy isn't perfectly aligned with it, you won't go to Heaven, no matter how good a person you perceive yourself to be.
