The **ROSETTE NEBULA**...is in the “**outer darkness**” of **deep space**. At Matthew 22:13 and 25:30, you can read what Jesus said about outer darkness and who’ll be cast into it.

Fortunately, I stumbled across the public domain cover image in early December, 2020. What got my attention was all that **RED**. It struck me as a substantial anomaly. What was it?

I started poking around on the Internet to learn more. DuckDuckGo® was my starting point. (Abandoned Google® quite a while ago... You may know why.) I searched for “What is the red color in the Rosette Nebula?” Every site I found told me the same thing: It’s sulfur. But isn’t sulfur yellow?

The next step was to confirm something I was pretty sure I already knew: that brimstone is the KJV word for sulfur in the scriptures. Merriam-Webster® online lists just one definition for the word, brimstone: sulfur.

✓ “...the **fearful**, and **unbelieving**, and the **abominable**, and **murderers**, and **whoremongers**, and **sorcerers**, and **idolaters**, and all¹ **liars**, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with **fire and BRIMSTONE**: which is the second death.” —Revelation 21:8

I then became curious regarding why the scriptures call it a **LAKE**. Surely enough, I found a video demonstration of how to burn sulfur: If you were to ignite just the tip of a small yellow pile of powdered sulfur, there’d be no need to add any more heat to it. That burning tip forms a super-hot liquid. Takes a while then, but that hot burning liquid soon begins to melt the adjacent yellow sulfur, turning it into a burning liquid, too...until the whole thing becomes a

- ✓ “A diffuse X-ray glow is...seen between the stars in the [Rosette Nebula] bubble, which has been attributed to a **SUPER-HOT PLASMA** with temperatures ranging from 1 to 10 million K...significantly hotter than the 10,000 K plasmas seen in HII regions, and is likely attributed to the shock-heated winds from the massive O-type stars.”

- ✓ “The Rosette Nebula is a large, circular hydrogen region located near one end of a giant molecular cloud in the Monoceros region of the Milky Way Galaxy...The Nebula is about 100 light years across and is about 5000 light years away.”

- ✓ “[In] the Rosette Nebula, narrowband images are combined to show emission from **SULFUR** atoms in **RED**, hydrogen in blue, and oxygen in green.” <https://science.nasa.gov/when-roses-arent-red>²

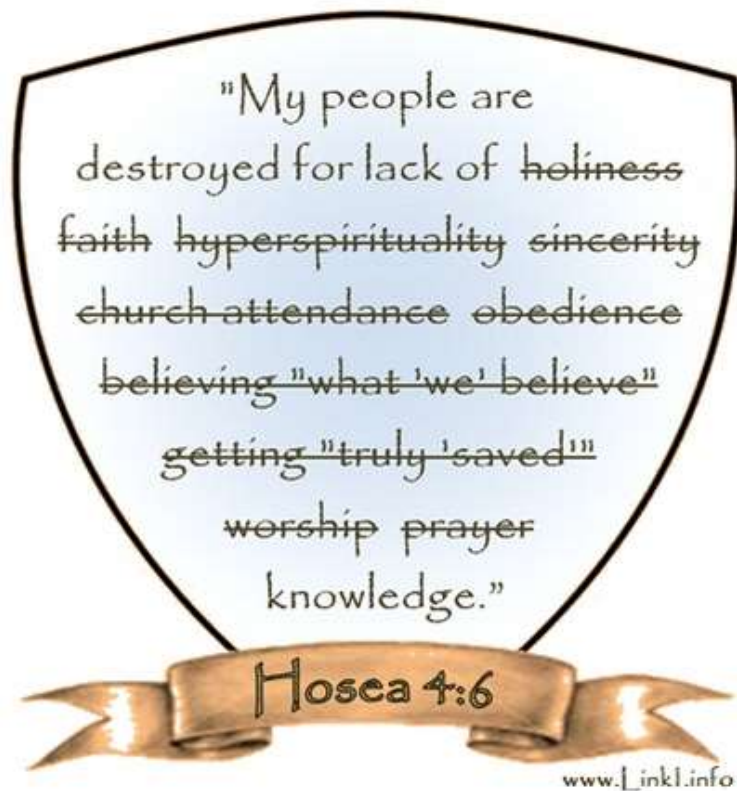
