The last Roman soldiers left Britain in AD 410. New people soon came from across the North Sea—northern Germany, northern Holland & northern Denmark: **Saxons**, **Iberians**, **Jutes** and **Caucasians**. Those are racial designations, but where did they come from, originally, and who exactly were they? If you're among the curious intelligent folk who enjoy research, you will still find it difficult to get credible answers to that question. The Clintonian "What difference, at this point, does it make?" question comes to mind. Our diligent digging has disclosed that it matters quite a lot! We think you may soon agree.



Remember The Lost Tribes of Israel? Lots of Bible "experts" still think those people were/are Jews. Not so! Only genetic descendants of the man, Judah, were/are Jews. If you're a Bible scholar, you may know that many of Benjamin's descendants were/are also legitimately called Jews – as were/are some of Levi's descendants.





Multitudes (not all) of Abraham's descendants were/are Hebrews. All of Jacob/Israel's descendants were/are Israelites. Israelites were/are Hebrews, but Jews were/are an extremely small percentage of Jacob/Israel's progeny.

Until the AD 600s, the Hebrew alphabet had no vowels: In Old English script, "Isaac's Sons" identified themselves as SXPS so, throughout the British Isles and other parts of Europe, they were called "Saxons. The racial designation, "Jutes," and Denmark's Jutland Peninsula likely came from the Jews who had also migrated North a couple hundred years later, initially to the German Baltic coastline, toward Poland.

The racial designation, "Iberian," was derived either from the man, Eber, or from the region by that name. That's also where the name, "Hebrew," came from. The Iberian Peninsula spans Portugal and Spain. It includes Andorra and a small part of France along the northeastern edge of it. Many are quite fascinated to learn that "Caucasians" were the Israelites and Jews who had traversed the Caucasian Pass, between the Black and Caspian Seas, on their long series of prophesied migrations from The Promised Land after their respective captivities, centuries before Christ's birth.

The serpent-like mark etched by the pagan Israelite tribe of **Dan** onto the European Continent was prophesied at Genesis 49:17. The **Danube River** starts in Germany and then passes through or touches the borders of Austria, Slovakia, Hungary, Croatia, Serbia, Romania, Bulgaria, Moldova and Ukraine before emptying into the Black Sea. And there's **Denmark** (>**Dan's mark**).
