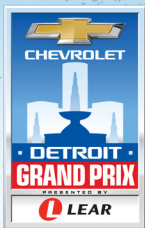

PARKING & SHUTTLE SERVICE

PUBLIC PARKING IS NOT AVAILABLE ON BELLE ISLE DURING THE GRAND PRIX WEEKEND

The Chevrolet Detroit Grand Prix presented by Lear offers complimentary round-trip shuttle service on luxury motorcoaches that run continuously between downtown Detroit and Belle Isle Park.

SUGGESTED PARKING LOCATIONS

- GM Renaissance Center surface lot (GM lot - east of the GM Renaissance Center on Atwater between St Antoine and Rivard St.)
The GM Lot is automated and only accepts credit cards.
Cost: \$10 per vehicle per day
- Beaubien Place Garage (corner of Beaubien & Atwater St.)
Cost: Maximum daily rate of \$25 per vehicle on Friday, Maximum daily rate of \$15 per vehicle on Saturday and Sunday
 - NOTE: For a faster and smoother exit: Pay your ticket at the kiosks on Level One or Level Two inside of Beaubien Garage before retrieving your vehicle.
 - The Level One Kiosk is located next to the elevators on Level One of the Beaubien Garage. The Level Two Kiosk is located directly at the base of the handicap ramp inside the Beaubien Garage.
- Port Atwater Garage (200 Beaubien St., between E. Jefferson Avenue and Atwater St.) Cost: Maximum daily rate of \$25 per vehicle on Friday, \$15 daily rate on Saturday and Sunday
- Surface lots, parking decks and street parking throughout downtown Detroit. Cost: Varies

SHUTTLE SERVICE LOCATIONS

Inbound to Belle Isle

- Stop 1: South side of Atwater St. at St. Antoine St.
- Stop 2: Midway on St. Antoine St. between Franklin and Atwater St.
- Stop 3: South side of Franklin St. near Rivard St. at the entrance to the River East Garage

Outbound from Belle Isle

- Stop 1: North side of Franklin St. at entrance to River East Garage
- Stop 2: Northwest corner of Atwater St. at Schweizer Place
- Stop 3: Northeast corner of Atwater St. at St. Antoine St.

DETROIT PEOPLE MOVER

The downtown Detroit shuttle bus locations are accessible from any downtown parking location by using the Detroit People Mover to the Millender Center stop and using the pedestrian bridge over Jefferson Avenue, connecting to the Renaissance Center.

NOTE: Guests can use the Q-Line from Midtown to connect with the Detroit People Mover at the Grand Circus Park Station.

Downtown Detroit Shuttle Operating Hours

All Shuttle Passengers, including Hospitality Guests will be dropped off and picked up at a staging area on Belle Isle known as the Shuttle Transportation Center. Shuttle buses run continuously during hours listed below.

Friday: 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.*

Saturday: 7:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.*

Sunday: 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.* *or until all guests are accommodated

WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE SHUTTLES

Several purpose-built, wheelchair accessible vans have been contracted to be of service to mobility challenged individuals who are unable to board the motorcoach shuttle buses or must be transported in wheelchairs. Each van holds two wheelchairs or electric mobility scooters at one time.

Shuttles will be deployed on demand to any of the shuttle stop locations east of the GM Renaissance Center in downtown Detroit. All suggested downtown Detroit parking lots are wheelchair accessible.

MOGO BIKE RENTAL

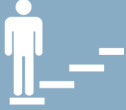

RIDESHARE

Uber and Lyft vehicles will be allowed to access Belle Isle for drop-off and pick-up of passengers. The Rideshare drop-off/pick-up location will remain the same, at the smaller circular drive in front of the Shuttle Transportation Center and close to the main entrance/exit of the Grand Prix venue.

TICKET & SEATING INFORMATION

TICKET WILL CALL CAR CORRAL PICK UP

VERIFY YOUR TICKET PACKAGE

Please check the contents of your ticket package upon receipt; verify ticket and pass quantities, event dates and seat locations. Report any discrepancies immediately to the Box Office. Ticket purchaser is completely responsible for tickets; we assume no responsibility for lost, stolen, misplaced or destroyed tickets. Duplicate tickets will not be issued.

Year-round Box Office: 300 Renaissance Center, Suite 2311, Detroit, MI 48243 (Level 2 – Wintergarden) Monday – Friday 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Belle Isle Ticket Office: Located on Belle Isle at the main entrance of the venue. Opens 7:30 a.m. daily – Closing times vary.

RESERVED SEAT GRANDSTANDS

Rows number from the top of the grandstand down to the row closest to the track. Grandstand 1 has Prix-mium seating (PS1 – PS4), followed by Row 1. NEWLY ADDED Grandstand 1A and Grandstand 2 have Row 1 as the top row.

Sections letter from left to right; section A would be on the left if you are standing in front of the grandstand looking at it. The seats number from left to right.

A ticket is required to occupy a reserved seat. Children 2 years of age and under are admitted free of charge when seated on parent's lap.

GENERAL ADMISSION TICKETS

General admission tickets are valid for standing room only viewing and provide access to the Viewing Platforms located adjacent to Grandstand 6 and in front of Grandstand 10. Personal lawn chairs are permitted to be brought into the venue but cannot be used on Viewing Platforms.

Youth 15 years of age and under are admitted free of charge to general admission areas when accompanied by a ticket-bearing adult; limit 2 children per adult admittance.

NEW FOR 2022 General Admission FLEX tickets provide access to the standing room viewing, Viewing Platforms and GA Grandstands 3, 6 and 10. Seating is on a first-come basis and is not guaranteed.

WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE SEATING

Only Grandstand 1 & 2 and Viewing Platform 10 are wheelchair accessible.

Guests in wheelchairs who need to cross the track should check in at the Accessibility Ambassadors tent located adjacent to the shuttle drop off area when they arrive to Belle Isle.

Track crossings are scheduled during designated times each day. Ambassadors can provide the times of track crossings and address any questions or needs.

WILL CALL POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Ticket orders placed in advance are mailed to addresses within the United States up until two weeks prior to the event; three weeks prior for foreign addresses. Ticket orders placed after the mail cut-off are held at Will Call for pick up from the Box Office. Will Call moves from the GM Renaissance Center Suite 2311 to the Race Weekend Ticket Office as of Friday, June 3.

Tickets are held under the last name of the party that will be picking up the prepaid tickets. Tickets cannot be released to a party other than the name set up in advance. Photo ID is required to pick up tickets. There are no cancellations of pre-purchased tickets and no refunds of unclaimed Will Call. The Grand Prix extends the courtesy of accepting third-party Will Call, however, we will not be responsible for package contents or non-receipt of package.

CAR CORRAL SALES & PICK UP

Car Corral packages include an on-island parking pass which must be displayed in the vehicle front window prior to approaching the MacArthur Bridge to Belle Isle.

Sales: Corral packages can be purchased online, by phone or through the Box Office in the GM Renaissance Center through 5:00 p.m. Thursday, June 2. As of Friday, June 3, Corral packages are sold at the Grand Prix Credential Center location only.

Pick-up: Corral packages that were purchased after our mail cut-off date can be picked up from the Box Office in the GM Renaissance Center through 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 2. As of Friday, June 3, Car Corral Pick-Up moves to the Grand Prix Credential Center located at 1801 Atwater Street, Detroit, MI 48207, housed within the Outdoor Adventure Center.

GATE ENTRY

ALLOWABLE ITEMS

The following items can be brought into the venue.

- Cameras, binoculars, scanners
- Coolers measuring 12" x 12" x 12" or less
- Seat cushions 18" or less
- Umbrellas, umbrella strollers, collapsible canvas wagons

NOTE: Umbrellas and umbrella strollers cannot be used in grandstands

All bags will be inspected, and must fit in a 12" x 12" x 12" space

INCREASED SECURITY MEASURES

Please be advised that security personnel will be present at each admission gate and guests will be screened prior to entering the venue by a hand-held wand device. Everyone who enters the venue is subject to search for illegal and prohibited items. Any items that are not on the prohibited list or illegal but may be considered suspicious are subject to confiscation and guests could be denied entry.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following items are NOT permitted to be brought into the venue. Items cannot be left at the gate.

- Ladders, scaffolding or other structures
- Large buggy strollers and hard-sided wagons
- Fireworks, firearms or other weapons
- Bicycles, roller blades, skateboards, hoverboards
- Video recording devices, camera stands, tripods or drones
- Glass bottles or open containers
- Alcohol beverages

Please Note: Bicycle parking is available adjacent to the Boat House parking lot outside the main admission gate.

Pets are not permitted; disability assistance dogs are permitted and MUST remain on leash. Grand Prix reserves the right to remove a service dog that impedes the enjoyment of guests or is considered a threat to others.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION TO KNOW

- Racing activities are held rain or shine.
- No rain checks or exchanges given.
- All sales are final. No refunds.
- Ticket upgrades are at the discretion of the Box Office.
- Participation in racing events as a spectator is at ticketholders own risk. Visit DetroitGP.com/Terms to view Terms of Sale.
- Tickets and other admission materials may not be used for advertising, promotions (including contests and sweepstakes) or other trade purposes, without the prior express written consent of Detroit Belle Isle Grand Prix, Inc.

- Tickets obtained from sources other than Detroit Belle Isle Grand Prix, Inc. may be lost, stolen or counterfeit and in such cases will not be honored.
- Tickets may not be resold on the premises.
- Ticket MUST be scanned when exiting the venue to be valid for re-entry.
- Venue is not responsible for unauthorized duplication of e-tickets. In the event of duplicate copies, venue reserves the right to refuse entry into the event.
- Detroit Belle Isle Grand Prix, Inc. reserves the right to remove any guest from the event, without refund, if their behavior is offensive or poses a hazard to others.





INCLEMENT WEATHER & EVACUATION

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE: There are no severe weather shelters at the Grand Prix and as an outdoor sporting event, we are subject to severe weather. The Grand Prix will notify guests of severe weather watches and warnings issued by the National Weather Service via jumbo video screens and public address announcements. Guests should also pay attention to weather conditions.

If you learn that a severe weather watch or warning has been issued by the National Weather Service or you sense that severe weather is likely, you should protect yourself and anyone who is with you by leaving Belle Isle Park as quickly as possible using the same means of transportation that brought you to the island. If severe weather strikes while you are on Belle Isle, take the following actions to protect yourself.

Thunderstorm & Lightning Safety – Exit grandstand and carefully move to ground level and away from the grandstand. Avoid high ground, water, tall isolated trees, metal objects such as fences, grandstands and temporary structures such as tents, canopies, etc. If you feel your skin tingle or hair stand on end, squat low to the ground on the balls of your feet. Make yourself the smallest target possible and minimize contact with the ground.

Tornado Safety – If you are caught outside in a tornado, lie flat on the ground preferably in a ditch or depression away from windows and grandstands. Cover your head with your hands and avoid flying debris. Do not seek shelter in a vehicle.

EVACUATION – In the event of an evacuation due to severe weather, follow the direction of authorities, pay close attention to jumbo video screens and public address announcements. Proceed to the Shuttle Transportation Center or personal vehicle if parked on-island.

Event activities will likely be postponed rather than cancelled due to weather. Buses will be staged downtown, awaiting activities to resume and will return guests to the island. Updates will be posted on the Grand Prix website and social media channels.

LOST & FOUND

Items that have been lost or found (i.e.: cell phone, camera, glasses, keys) should be reported to a PNC Bank Information Booth. Information booth volunteers are in radio contact with each booth and will assist with the possible return of lost items. All unclaimed items turned in over the weekend are taken to the Grand Prix office after the event.

Should you realize that you have lost an item after leaving Belle Isle, you can contact us at 313-748-1800 after the Grand Prix weekend to check if the item has been recovered.

Should you or a member of your party become separated, please report to a PNC Bank Information Booth for assistance. Lost children are held at the closest information booth for approximately 30 minutes prior to calling the authorities.

PNC BANK INFORMATION BOOTH LOCATIONS

A total of five PNC Bank Information Booths are conveniently located throughout the venue

- Shuttle Transportation Center drop-off area
- Meijer Fan Zone (across from the foot of the Chevrolet Bridge)
- Across from the entrance to the Fifth Third Bank Paddock (just past the Huntington Bank Bridge)
- In the Fountain Fan Area, between the Party Patio and Grandstand 10
- Inside the Fifth Third Bank Paddock, along the walkway leading to or from the Chevrolet Front Stretch Bridge

At each booth you can get general event information, maps, most current schedules and directions.

MICHELIN CAR CORRAL

Corrals include Corvette, Cadillac, Porsche and the Grand Prix Corral featuring a mix of sport cars, collector and historical vehicles. Check out the cars on display and chat with fellow owners.

MEIJER FAN ZONE

The Meijer Fan Zone hosts a wide range of fun activities for fans of all ages. The popular "Sports District" is back again in 2022, offering fans the chance to meet some of their favorite Detroit sports team legends and receive free personalized autographs on Saturday & Sunday, noon to 4 pm. Guests will have the opportunity to put their own football, baseball and basketball skills to the test with Meijer's interactive sporting stations. Fans can capture memories of their Grand Prix experience with a free photo on one of three BIG Chairs.

New additions to the Meijer Fan Zone include the DTE Energy EV Garage, the American Legion display, and the Detroit Grand Prix Legacy Display celebrating 22 events on Belle Isle.

NEW THIS YEAR! THE FOUNTAIN FAN AREA

Located between the Fifth Third Bank Paddock and Grandstand 10, across from the Scott Fountain. The Fountain Fan Area is the new home of our Entertainment Stage, providing musical entertainment throughout the weekend. Check out the Jack Daniels Party Porch, a great place to take a break and enjoy an adult beverage. WRIF will be broadcasting live from this area and there will be several interactive displays, including a pop-up from T-Mobile as well as tailgating games. Masters Endurance Legends USA Paddock

Masters Endurance Legends USA Participant Paddock is located adjacent to the Meijer Fan Zone, along Picnic Way. A series for Gentlemen drivers and their Prototypes and GT Endurance Cars offering a dedicated grid reflecting a snapshot of endurance racing history in North America. This Series caters to a broad range of cars and showcases endurance races from the Group C/GTP era of 1982 right up to their modern equivalents of 2017. Grand Prix Legacy Display

Located in the Meijer Fan Zone, the Grand Prix Legacy Display will honor the history of the event on Belle Isle and provide a preview to the future of the Grand Prix and its return to the Streets of Downtown Detroit in 2023. Through classic photography and historical video highlights, visitors to the Legacy Display will take a tour through four decades of world-class racing on Belle Isle. The collection of Official Grand Prix posters since 1992 will be on display to reflect on the event’s unique island heritage. Fans will also be able to relive some of the most memorable moments from the Grand Prix on Belle Isle through a free digital photo service featuring green screen technology that will allow visitors to be featured in some of the signature places on the island circuit so they can share their favorite memories on social media.

IMSA CLASS COLORS

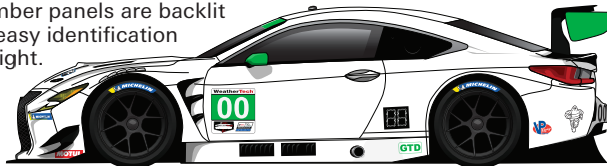
To help fans easily identify a class of car, the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship uses a color system.

The DAYTONA PROTOTYPE INTERNATIONAL class is designated by BLACK markings on the number panel and WHITE leader lights.

The GT DAYTONA class is designated by GREEN markings on the number panel, mirrors, windscreen banner, rear wing end plates and leader lights.



Number panels are backlit for easy identification at night.



LEADER LIGHT SYSTEM

To help fans follow the on-track action, IMSA uses a Leader Light System. It allows fans to easily identify the position of each car in its respective class.



The car's position is displayed on an LED panel mounted on the side of the car and the color of the LED number corresponds with the class.

For instance, an illuminated LED GREEN number 5 on an GTD style car means that car is in 5th position in the GTD class.

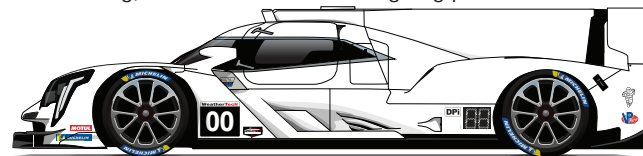

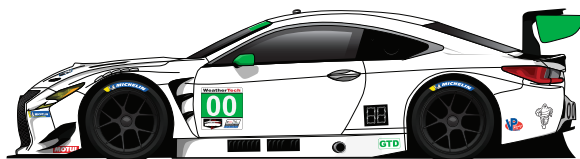

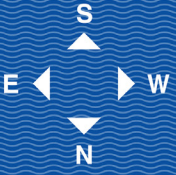
