Mary MacGregor, Director of Leadership Development in the Diocese of Texas. Nationally recognized speakers on leadership development will offer workshops on such topics as:

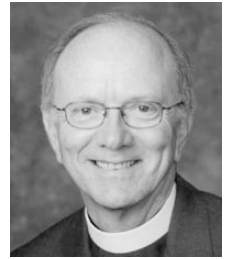
